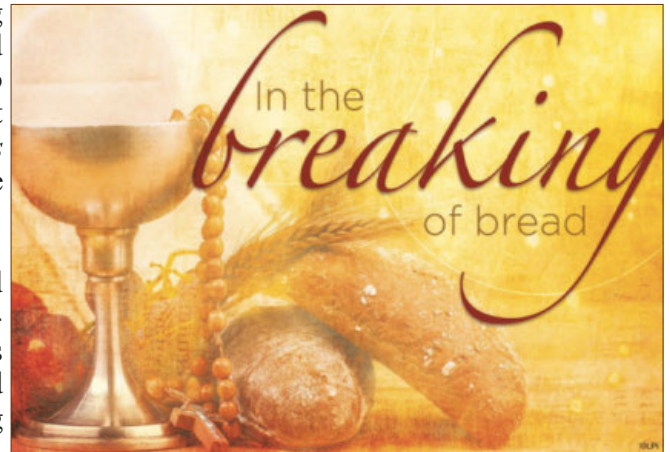

## Father Frank's Fire

In today's gospel, we begin after the story of Jesus joining two of his disciples on their way to a village called Emmaus. Jesus joined them along the way and began to engage them in conversation about the recent events that happened in Jerusalem. The gospel tells us "how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of the bread." The disciples recount this great story and Jesus appears again.



Again, Jesus encounters his disciples that are troubled and afraid, for they still do not fully understand the Resurrection. Jesus reveals that he is alive. What I enjoy about this story is that Jesus joined them along the road. This is good news for us because we know that Jesus often joins us along our journey. Perhaps we have failed to recognize the presence of Jesus in our lives. Sometimes when we are in the midst of grief, anxiety or disappointment, it is often difficult to see Jesus in our midst. Conversely, sometimes when we are in the midst of joy, happiness and everything seems to be going our way – we, likewise, fail to recognize Jesus in our midst.

Like the disciples, we, too, recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread. When we approach the altar to receive Jesus in the Eucharist the minister says, "*The Body of Christ.*" We reply, "*AMEN,*" which means "*I Believe!*"

As Jesus appeared to the disciples, "they were incredulous with joy and were amazed." The prayers during the Easter season reflect to us the joy that we should be feeling. We celebrate Easter for 50 days. The Preface to the Eucharistic Prayer says, "*Therefore, overcome with paschal joy.*" To be overcome means to be amazed, dazed, speechless, stunned or overwhelmed. To be overwhelmed with joy that Jesus is Risen. How wonderful would our world be if we lived our lives in simple awe of Christ's love and His Resurrection. Let us pray for such joy in our lives.

### CAR CARAVAN

I entered Mt. Carmel High School in 1977, graduated in 1981 and have been a "Caravan" ever since. I also thought the idea of a team named "Caravan" was rather strange. Today, it makes a little more sense to me. A caravan is a group travelling together to reach the same destination, a sort of unity in order to achieve a goal.

## 3rd Sunday of Easter

### April 14, 2024

Today's gospel reading from Luke recounts the story of what took

place after the Resurrection. Jesus appears to His disciples at the Sea of Galilee. He brings His peace and calms their troubled hearts. Sometimes we need to take some time, too, to reflect upon what happens around us.

Today St. Michael parishioners will be joining a car caravan with other parishes in our grouping to celebrate together the Year of the Eucharist. We will be a visible sign . . . literally . . . on the road in our community. We will stop and pray and adore our Eucharistic Lord. Like the disciples at the seashore, may we take time from our busy lives to sit, pray and reflect on the Lord's actions in our lives, and may we share our experiences with others—even strangers.

Jesus will calm our fears and strengthen our belief. Before this post-Resurrection encounter with Jesus, the disciples simply could not comprehend all that had happened. Maybe sometimes—over 2,000 years later, neither can we. But rest assured, Jesus is with us always—Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

Like the disciples, it may take a lot for us to truly know and understand. Many times we will fail to see Jesus right in front of us. Only through the power of the Resurrection did the disciples realize the significance of their relationship with Jesus. Only through the power of the Resurrection could they act through, with and in the Risen Jesus to be a sign for others. Let us pray for God's grace to be a sign for our Orland Park community today. . . and every day!

Have you ever been scared of a ghost story or movie? Do you believe in ghosts? Now, this may seem strange to be talking about during Easter season, but I can assure you this is directly related

to the Gospel for this week. In bible times, some people believed in ghosts and were afraid of them.

This story begins with two men discussing the crucifixion of Jesus and all of the events that had taken place in the past few days. They wondered what it all meant. As they walked together, trying to figure it out, they were joined by a stranger. They did not recognize that the stranger was actually Jesus! They were very afraid of him because they thought Jesus was a ghost.

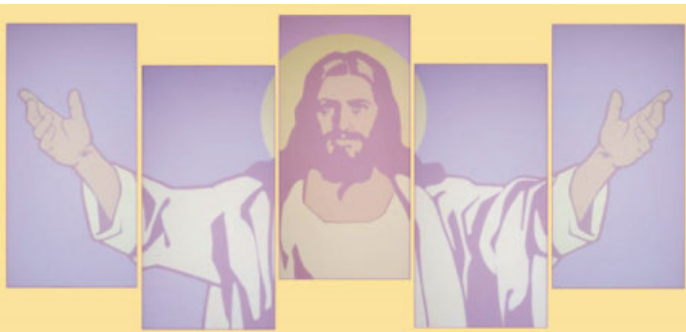
Jesus told them not to be afraid. The two men found Jesus' disciples and began telling them what they had seen. Then as they said these things, Jesus himself stood with them and said to them, "Peace be with you!" Do you think the disciples felt peace? NO! The bible says that they were terrified and filled with fear, thinking that this was a ghost.

Once again Jesus spoke and asked His disciples why they were troubled and why they had doubts in their hearts. "Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies. You can see that I do!" Jesus showed them the nail scars from the crucifixion in his hands and feet.

"A ghost doesn't have skin and bones as I DO." Still the disciples didn't believe. So Jesus asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of fish, and he ate it while they watched. That was even further proof that they were not seeing a ghost! A ghost doesn't need food.

When the disciples finally realized that it was Jesus and not a ghost, Jesus began to teach them. He explained that he had to suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day to prove what was written about him in scripture. He told the disciples that they needed to spread the word to the world! The disciples had seen Jesus die. They had seen him be placed in a tomb. But now they saw Jesus alive! Those same disciples went all over the world, telling the story of Jesus' crucifixion, and his death and resurrection. They never stopped telling the story during their whole lives. You and I have been called to tell the story just like those disciples. We must be witnesses for Jesus, too. We must tell the world that Jesus is alive!

***Let's pray: Jesus, You are alive and You feed us in many ways. May we remember that You are not a ghost, but a real person who was sent to us by God, our Heavenly Father. Amen***

## El Espiritu del Padre Frank

En el evangelio de hoy, comenzamos después de la historia de Jesús uniéndose a dos de sus discípulos en su camino a un pueblo llamado Emaús. Jesús se unió a ellos en el camino y comenzó a conversar con ellos sobre los recientes acontecimientos en Jerusalén. El evangelio nos cuenta “*cómo se les dio a conocer a Jesús al partir el pan*”. Los discípulos cuentan esta increíble historia y Jesús aparece nuevamente.



Nuevamente Jesús se encuentra con sus discípulos, preocupados y asustados, porque todavía no comprenden plenamente la Resurrección. Jesús revela que está vivo. Disfruto esta historia porque Jesús se unió a ellos en el camino. Esta es una buena noticia porque Jesús a menudo se une a nosotros en nuestro camino. Necesitamos reconocer la presencia de Jesús en nuestras vidas. A veces, cuando estamos en medio del dolor, la ansiedad o la desilusión, suele ser difícil ver a Jesús entre nosotros. Por el contrario, a veces, cuando estamos en medio de la alegría y la felicidad, y todo parece ir como queremos, no reconocemos a Jesús entre nosotros.

Como los discípulos, también nosotros podemos reconocer a Jesús en la fracción del pan. Cuando nos acercamos al altar para recibir a Jesús en la Eucaristía, el ministro dice: “*El Cuerpo de Cristo.*” Respondemos “*AMÉN*”, una poderosa afirmación que se traduce como “*¡Creo!*” Este acto de reconocimiento no es sólo un ritual, sino una profunda conexión espiritual con Jesús.

Cuando Jesús se apareció a los discípulos, “ellos estaban incrédulos de alegría y asombrados. Las oraciones durante el tiempo pascual reflejan esta alegría que deberíamos sentir. Celebramos la Pascua durante 50 días. El Prefacio a la Plegaria Eucarística dice: “Por tanto, llenaos de alegría pascual”. Ser superado significa estar asombrado, aturdido, sin palabras, aturdido o abrumado. Sentirse abrumados por la alegría de que Jesús haya resucitado. Imagine la belleza de nuestro mundo si viviéramos nuestras vidas con simple asombro por el amor de Cristo y Su resurrección. Oremos por esa alegría abrumadora en nuestras vidas.

### CARAVANAS DE AUTOS

Entré a la escuela secundaria Mt. Carmel en 1977, me gradué en 1981 y he sido una “caravana” desde entonces. También pensé que la idea de un equipo llamado “caravana” era bastante extraña. 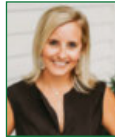

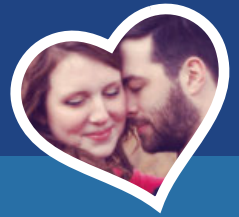
