Father Frank's Fire


Alleluia! With this simple word, I announce to you greetings of Easter joy. Easter is the day of Resurrection, a day of new hope, of new beginnings, and of new life. This is a day to celebrate for Christ our Lord is Risen from the dead and He is victorious over sin and death.

I welcome our many visitors to St. Michael this Easter Day. I am glad that you are here. **YOU** make our Easter joy complete. I trust that you will feel the presence of the Risen Lord among us.

The Gospel tells us that in the early morning Jesus left the empty tomb behind. It was an ordinary day in Jerusalem. There was not a major earthquake, nor were there loud blasts of thunder, not even a trumpet sounded. The only thing that was unusual was the empty tomb. The disciples entered the empty tomb – they saw and believed.

The empty tomb reminds us that we have a future and we can move past the stones that have blocked us from encountering the Risen Christ. Nothing, not even death, can keep us away from Jesus. We should not be afraid, because Jesus walks with us. This Easter Day let us live in the light and love of the Risen Christ.

This Lent we walked as Pilgrims of Hope during this Jubilee Year. We have celebrated His passion and death, and now we are ready to rise to new life. St. Michael Parish was formed in 1867. We have accomplished much in these past 158 years, but there is still work to be done. The Gospel must be preached, the poor provided for, our Catholic faith taught to our children, and our Catholic faith strengthened and nourished in adults. Easter gives us the perfect opportunity to recommit ourselves to continue the mission of Jesus.



I ask that you help me to announce to the world the love of Jesus Christ Crucified and Risen from the Dead. St. Michael has had a wonderful past and we need to celebrate our parish. We can have an even more glorious future if we are willing to work together to face the challenges that we encounter. I pray that we have the courage to follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit and bring Easter joy to all that we meet.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Saint John Paul II declared that the Second Sunday of Easter is to be Divine Mercy Sunday. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy are based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun that received revelations about God's mercy. The message of mercy is nothing new, but it is a reminder of what the Church has always taught — that God is merciful and forgiving, and that we, too, must show mercy and forgiveness to others. I invite all to devote a part of this day to prayer.

We will celebrate Divine Mercy with a special Holy Hour, next Sunday, April 27, at 3:00 p.m. in the Church. All are invited to come to pray and to reflect on Divine Mercy.



Happy Easter! Today is the day that we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ! Easter marks the end of Lent – 40 days that I hope have helped you to feel closer to God and grow in your faith.

On the Sunday after Jesus was crucified, Mary Magdalene and another woman named Mary went to visit the tomb where Jesus had been buried. When they arrived, the stone that had covered the tomb had been rolled away, and an angel was sitting on it. What a surprise for them to see!

"Don't be afraid," the angel said to them. "I know you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here, He has risen, just as He said He would. Come, see the place where He lay. Then go quickly and tell His disciples."

The two women looked in and saw that the tomb was empty and hurried away. They were surprised and afraid, yet they were filled with joy! That is when they saw Jesus and began to worship him! Jesus said to them, "Don't be afraid! Go tell my brothers to leave for Galilee, and they will see me there."

Now, that is the real Easter surprise! They went to see Jesus in the tomb, but he was not there. He had risen! That is why, when we celebrate Easter, we rejoice by saying, "He is risen!" All the pain and sorrow that Jesus went through was finally a sigh of relief – He is risen! All the people that were sad for Him knew all that He did was for us so that, we too, will see the glory of God!




Ministers of Care Needed to Bring Communion to the Sick & Homebound




