### Father Frank's Fire

In today's gospel, Jesus refers to himself as the Good Shepherd. The image of the Good Shepherd has been a source of hope and consolation to the Church for centuries. In the gospel, Jesus tells us, "I will lay down my life for the sheep." Certainly, there is no greater love than that of Jesus for his people. One of the significant challenges of the Christian life is to imitate the Good Shepherd and the willingness to lay down our lives for another. We do this by serving each other. There are some that desire to be our leaders. They make us empty promises in exchange for our support. Sadly, they do not want leadership because they are concerned about us – but for their own power and personal advantage. They want their names in the newspapers filled with accolades. This is not the leadership envisioned in the gospel. Authentic Christian leadership is that of service – the willingness to lay down your life for another. To be like Christ; to give and not to count the cost. Do not be fooled by those who want leadership roles but are not willing to serve. The image of the Good Shepherd is the model of true leadership.

#### 4th Sunday of Easter April 21, 2024



The first reading today tells the story of Peter healing a man who was born crippled. Afterward, Peter and John spoke to the crowd that witnessed the miraculous healing.

The Saduccees, who did not believe resurrection,

were furious that Peter and John were proclaiming that Jesus was raised from death. They arrested Peter and John, and threw them into jail. The next day, the two were interrogated. But the Holy Spirit emboldened Peter, and he used the image of a cornerstone that Jesus had used to speak about himself. Peter's speech was so powerful that the authorities let them go with only a warning.

When has the Holy Spirit emboldened me to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ? What happened?

In today's gospel Jesus explains what our relationship with Him should look like. Jesus is like a shepherd who lovingly cares for his sheep and would give his life, rather than abandon us.

- How can I apply the image of the Good Shepherd to Pope Francis and others, as they lead Jesus' flock in the Catholic Church today?
- How do I shepherd others as we journey together in faith? Who else is a Good Shepherd for me? How do they protect and guide us?

A shepherd is someone who takes care of sheep. If you are familiar with sheep, they can be very calm animals. They need a shepherd to watch over them because other fierce animals can

attack them. A good shepherd will protect his flock and risk his own life to save one of his animals from a wolf or other hungry animal. When Jesus told the people that he was "the good shepherd," he wanted them to understand that he was there to help them, not hurt them. He wanted the people to follow him, like sheep follow their shepherd, so that they would learn how to live in peace with one another. He also wanted them to understand that he would risk his own life to save them and us!

If you have ever owned a pet - you are something like a shepherd. You take care of your pet by making sure it has enough water, food and exercise to keep it healthy. If you ever see that your pet is in danger, I am sure that you will do your best to protect it. So imagine this love for your pet. That is how God loves each and every one of US – but even more!

This is an amazing way for Jesus to explain how we are like sheep. If you have ever seen sheep in a flock, there are many for the shepherd to watch over. The shepherd cares for all of the sheep, without exceptions. They belong to him and his job is to care for them, and love each and every one of them the in the same way.

Jesus wanted us to understand that God loves us in the same way. Even though there are billions of people living in the world, He watches over each and every one of us. He wants to lead ALL of us to him. Even though some of us will wander off and not follow him, he will never abandon us. He will always welcome us back into His arms as long as we promise to follow him and love him.

People will come in and out of our lives. They may try to lead us away from Jesus. They may get us to do things that go against what our parents teach us and what God teaches us. God understands that this can be hard for us—that is why He sent Jesus to us. He sent Jesus to teach us how to get to heaven to be with God.






