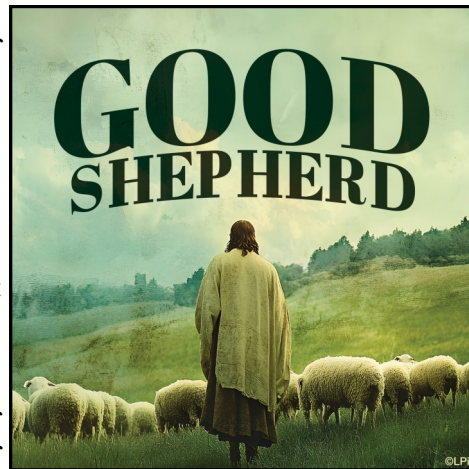

FR. FRANK'S FIRE

Happy Easter! Yes, it is still Easter. We celebrate Easter for fifty days and that leads us to Pentecost Sunday – the birthday of the Church.

Our first reading today comes from the Acts of the Apostles. In this book, we learn of the growth of the early Church after the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. It is amazing to me how the disciples changed from frightened men hiding in the upper room to powerful preachers always bearing witness to Christ Jesus. What is the cause of this transformation from fright to strength? The answer is simple; it is the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is what gives us the courage to proclaim the name of Jesus to the ends of the earth. It is the Holy Spirit that guides us and helps us to understand the message of Jesus. Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized, everyone of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” We too have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit at our baptism. We also need to repent. All of us have sinned and all of us are in need of repentance. If we are willing to repent, God offers us the gift of forgiveness. May we be willing to change our lives and walk in the presence of the Risen Lord.



The Fourth Sunday of Easter is Good Shepherd Sunday. The Gospel reminds us that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who loves and cares for us, his sheep. Jesus is the one that leads us on our journey of life, “he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they recognize his voice.” It is comforting to hear the voice of one who loves and cares for you. There is a sense of security when we follow one who loves us. I think our parents are like the Good Shepherd. They journey with us along the road of life and they try to teach us important lessons. I think that parents go out of their way to make sure that their children, young or old, remember the lessons that they try to teach us. We do not always learn the lessons until years later, but parents try and never give up. It took me a long time to recognize my parent’s wisdom. Even today, years after their deaths, I can still hear them trying to show me the way.

Generation To Generation

Most of you should have received some information in the mail regarding the Archdiocese of Chicago’s Generation to Generation: Answer the Call campaign. We are beginning to enter into the public phase of reaching out to all parishioners to ask them to make a sacrificial pledge to the campaign to-be-paid over five years.

I like you, received a personalized letter from the Cardinal asking for a sacrificial gift. I have always said that I would not ask you to do anything that I myself am not willing to do. After a lot of thought and prayer, I made the first pledge.

St. Michael has been a parish since 1867. In September, it will be 159 years of spreading the Gospel. We have benefitted from the sacrifices of those who have gone before us, many of your parents and grandparents. It is now our turn to help support the Church so that we, like those before us, can pass on the faith to the generations that will follow us. If we do not do this, who will? St. Michael does not have any debt because those who came before built and paid for the buildings that we now use and perhaps take for granted. We have a church to worship in and buildings to educate our children – buildings that others have sacrificed for. I ask you to join me, in prayerfully considering a sacrificial gift to Generation To Generation: Answer the Call campaign.

Hey Kids!



We hear the word **REPENT** a lot when we talk about sins/doing bad things. But what does **REPENT** mean? Sins are different from mistakes because with sins, you **DO** know better. A mistake is something that you just did wrong without meaning to do it. Example: A mistake: bumping into someone when you are passing them in the hallway. A sin: pushing someone to make them fall. When we **REPENT**, we are saying that we are sorry for sinning, but then also trying our best to never repeat that sin again.

How can we grow with Jesus? One way is to be sorry for our sins and to ask for forgiveness. We can repent each time we sin. We can go to confession, confess our sins and our souls will be made clean. We must try our best not to repeat the same sins that are washed away. When we sin or do something bad - let us try to **REPENT** by following these steps. 1) When we know we have done wrong, listen to what the Holy Spirit is telling us to do; then do it. 2) Say we are sorry. When we say we are sorry, we are recognizing that we did something wrong. 3) Ask for forgiveness. This is different from saying sorry - this is asking if everything is now okay and how we can make up for what we did. 4) Make it right. What can you do to make it better? Once you know what to do, do it! 5) Go and grow. Learn from what you did. Truly **REPENT** by not repeating the sin.

Let's pray: Jesus, I want to be just like you! **GO AND GROW!** Amen.

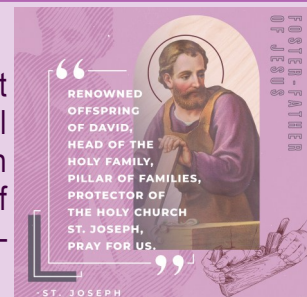

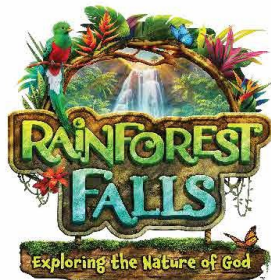

EL ESPIRITU DE PADRE FRANK

¡Felices Pascuas! Sí, todavía es tiempo de Pascua. Celebramos la Pascua durante cincuenta días, y eso nos conduce al Domingo de Pentecostés: el cumpleaños de la Iglesia.

Nuestra primera lectura de hoy proviene de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. En este libro, conocemos el crecimiento de la Iglesia primitiva tras la Ascensión de Jesús a los cielos. Me resulta asombroso ver cómo los discípulos pasaron de ser hombres atemorizados, escondidos en el Cenáculo, a convertirse en predicadores poderosos que daban testimonio constante de Cristo Jesús. ¿Cuál es la causa de esta transformación, de la angustia a la fortaleza? La respuesta es sencilla: es el don del Espíritu Santo. Es el Espíritu Santo quien nos infunde el valor para proclamar el nombre de Jesús hasta los confines de la tierra. Es el Espíritu Santo quien nos guía y nos ayuda a comprender el mensaje de Jesús. Pedro les dijo: “Arrepiéntanse y bautícese, cada uno de ustedes, en el nombre de Jesucristo para el perdón de sus pecados; y recibirán el don del Espíritu Santo”. A nosotros también se nos ha concedido el don del Espíritu Santo en nuestro bautismo. Nosotros también necesitamos arrepentirnos. Todos hemos pecado y todos necesitamos arrepentimiento. Si estamos dispuestos a arrepentirnos, Dios nos ofrece el don del perdón. Que estemos dispuestos a cambiar nuestras vidas y a caminar en la presencia del Señor Resucitado.



El Cuarto Domingo de Pascua es el Domingo del Buen Pastor. El Evangelio nos recuerda que Jesús es el Buen Pastor que nos ama y cuida de nosotros, sus ovejas. Jesús es quien nos guía en nuestro camino por la vida: “él camina delante de ellas, y las ovejas lo siguen porque reconocen su voz”. Resulta reconfortante escuchar la voz de alguien que te ama y cuida de ti. Se experimenta una sensación de seguridad cuando seguimos a alguien que nos ama. Creo que nuestros padres son como el Buen Pastor. Recorren el camino de la vida junto a nosotros e intentan enseñarnos lecciones importantes. Pienso que los padres se desviven por asegurarse de que sus hijos —sean jóvenes o adultos— recuerden las lecciones que ellos procuran inculcarles. No siempre aprendemos esas lecciones hasta años más tarde; sin embargo, los padres lo siguen intentando y nunca se dan por vencidos. A mí me llevó mucho tiempo reconocer la sabiduría de mis padres. Incluso hoy, años después de su fallecimiento, todavía puedo oírlos intentando mostrarme el camino.

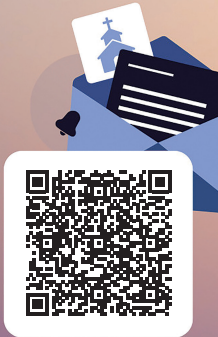

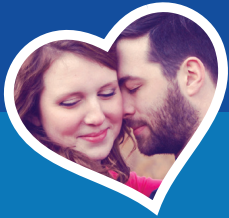
