"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and everyone that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit." - Jn 15:1-2

Father Frank's Fire

In today's gospel Jesus tells us, "I am the vine, you are the branches." The gospel tells us that we are very much connected to Christ – In fact, Jesus is our lifeline. When a branch is cut off from the vine, it dies, because it has no life. The same is true for us. When we are cut off from Christ, we wither up because LIFE is not running through our beings. Jesus goes on further to tell us, "Without me you can do nothing." This is so true. How many times have we tried to do something without Christ? How many times have we failed? If we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, we cannot fail. Today may our prayer be that we never be separated from Christ and, with the help of the Holy Spirit and each other, let us bear fruit – that is let us make a difference in our world. We can make a difference in the world – but only if Christ is the center of our lives.

The Power of Prayer

A few months ago, I mentioned that I would like to start a new prayer ministry. I am a firm believer in the power of prayer. Some people underestimate what is possible through prayer. Intercessory prayer is when one person prays for the needs of another. Many times people leave Mass asking the priests to pray for them or for one of their loved ones. It is a privilege to pray for someone and that should not be taken lightly.

Everyone can offer these types of prayers. I would like to form prayer teams that would be available after Mass to pray for others. Instead of coming to the priest and asking for a prayer sometime in the future — the prayer teams will be available and offer the prayer with the asker. I know that many feel embarrassed about asking for prayer. There is nothing to fear, for prayer is so powerful. Some may feel reluctant to pray for others because they do not know the words. Again, there is nothing to fear, as there is no wrong way to pray.

My vision is to begin slowly — Perhaps selecting a weekend once a quarter. Prayer teams will be available after each Mass that weekend to pray with those seeking prayer. A priest will be available for those seeking the Sacrament of the Sick. My initial thought is to call this weekend a Day of Prayer and Healing.

In order to form this ministry, I will need volunteers to form prayer teams. No experience is necessary. Formation will be offered so that the prayer intercessors become comfortable praying with others. Remember Jesus says that where two or three gather in his name – he will take his place among them.

I ask that you think about if God is calling you to be part of a prayer team. I would like to invite you to an **initial meeting on Tuesday, May 28 at 6:30PM**. Have you ever noticed that when Jesus was teaching, he often told stories to help his followers understand what he wanted them to learn? The

Gospel for today is another shining example of these stories. This story was about grapevines. He chose the grapevine for this story because in the land where Jesus lived, there were many grapevines. Jesus knew that his followers would know a lot about grapevines. I don't know if you have ever seen a grapevine, but there are two parts to the grapevine. There is the vine, and there are many branches growing out of the vine. The grapes grow on the branches. That is pretty much like any fruit; they grow on the branches. The only way that a branch can have fruit on it is for it to remain connected. If a stem broke off, anything growing on it would wither away and die.

Recently, I was working in the yard and I found a branch laying on the ground. I realized it had no leaves and no sign of life left in it. If it had come from a nearby fruit tree, it would never have had any fruit on it. That is what Jesus wanted his followers to understand as he told his story about the grapevine. He wanted them to understand how important it was for them to stay connected to him. He told them, "I am the vine and you are the branches. If you remain in me, you will have much fruit, but apart from me, you can do nothing." Jesus wants you and me to produce fruit in our life. He wants us to be kind, gentle, generous and loving to each other. Do you believe we can do that on our own without Jesus? NO WAY!

Just as the branches must be connected to the vine before they can produce fruit, you and I must stay connected to Jesus to produce the good fruit that God expects of us. If we keep our life connected to Jesus, we will grow. When we stay connected to Jesus, we will try our best to please him, and to do good instead of bad. Just like a grapevine produces delicious fruit, our life will produce beautiful gestures of peace, forgiveness and love that we can give to one another. But if we separate from Jesus, we may do things that go against everything Jesus taught us.

Let's pray: Jesus, help us to remain faithful as we stay connected to you, and follow your teaching. Amen.

Love of Jesus in the Eucharist Brings Vicariate Together In Recent Car Caravan Pilgrimage

It's one of many programs Leading us to the National Eucharistic Congress in July



The Holy Spirit and our love of Jesus in the Eucharist brought more than 250 people together for our Eucharistic Revival Car Caravan Pilgrimage on Sunday, April 14. Nearly 100 cars participated in the caravan that began with worship and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Michael. Together we traveled from our parish to St. Francis of Assisi Parish and then onto Our Lady of the Woods, adoring Jesus in the Eucharist as the body of Christ.

As part of a Holy Spirit-led initiative centering on the Eucharist, the Vicariate V Deanery Parishes are collaborating on several activities and programs to bring our faith communities together to worship and adore the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ that is present in the Blessed Sacrament. Our collaboration is part of the **National Eucharistic Revival**, a movement to restore understanding and devotion to the great mystery of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, which will culminate with the **10th National Eucharistic Congress** in Indianapolis this July.

"Jesus invites all of us to return to the source and summit of our faith, which is the celebration of the Eucharist," said Fr. Geofrey. "It is the center of who we are as Catholics. We hope that through our local programs and by attending the National Eucharistic Congress this summer, we will reignite in the hearts of many the love for Jesus that is present in the Eucharist."

The National Eucharistic Congress, the first in 83 years, takes place July 17-21, 2024 in Indianapolis. Every day at the Congress is designed to facilitate a life-changing encounter with Jesus, regardless of where you are on your faith journey. Attendees will select their preferred series of impact sessions for the morning and breakout sessions for the afternoon. Then, gathered together as one, the whole assembly will experience the powerful revival sessions in Lucas Oil Stadium each evening.

Si mantenemos nuestros ojos fijos en Jesús, no podemos fallar. Que hoy nuestra oración sea que nunca nos separemos de Cristo y, con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, hagamos una diferencia unos en otros, llevemos a cabo nuestro mundo. Podemos marcar una diferencia en el mundo, pero sólo si Cristo es el centro de nuestras vidas.

El Poder de la Oracion

Una vez más, no hay nada que temer, ya que no existe una forma incorrecta de orar.

Mi visión es comenzar lentamente. Quizás seleccionando un fin de semana una vez al trimestre. Los equipos de oración estarán disponibles después de cada Misa ese fin de semana para orar con aquellos que buscan oración. Habrá un sacerdote disponible para quienes busquen el Sacramento de los Enfermos. Mi pensamiento inicial es llamar a este fin de semana un Día de Oración y Sanación.

Para poder formar este ministerio, necesitaré voluntarios para formar equipos de oración. No es necesaria experiencia. Se ofrecerá formación para que los intercesores de oración se sientan cómodos orando con los demás. Recuerde que Jesús dice que donde dos o tres se reúnan en su nombre, él ocupará su lugar entre ellos.
