

Father Frank's Fire

In today's second reading St. Paul tell us, "*Have no anxiety at all.*" St. Paul obviously does not realize that there are only 10 days until Christmas. Many people are filled anxiety this week. We are trying to finish our Christmas cards and Christmas shopping. What is another trip to the mall with the pushy crowds and traffic? We need to make sure that our homes are properly decorated and that our Christmas dinner is planned and bought. Have no anxiety? Please we are filled with anxiety and worry.

The words of John the Baptist in today's gospel should cause us all anxiety: "*His winnowing fan is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire.*" Again, the scriptures remind us of a judgment day and a separation of the good from the evil. We are given the opportunity to look at our lives and make the necessary changes to make sure we are living the way Jesus taught us.

The people asked John, "*What should we do?*" His answer was not only directed to them, but to us. What we should do is love each other, care for each other, and forgive each other. Where there is love, compassion and forgiveness – God is present.

This Sunday is *Gaudete Sunday*, which means Rejoice. The rose candle on the Advent wreath is lit and the circle of light is almost complete. The prophet Zephaniah calls us to rejoice and not to be discouraged because God is in our midst. Yes, we rejoice for we know that Emmanuel has come – God with us.

Advent is one of those strange seasons where we prepare for the coming of Christ. We acknowledge that Jesus was already born into time so we prepare for his coming into our hearts, lives and world anew this Christmas. When Christ is the center of our lives, the rest falls into place and into proper perspective. We also need to prepare for the coming of Jesus in glory. We should get ourselves prepared for judgment by living the life of a child of God. If you have not taken advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in a while, I urge you to do so. What better way to prepare ourselves for Christ's coming than to be free from sin? Confessions will be heard on Saturday, Dec. 21 from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m.

So let us rejoice this weekend and try to put St. Paul's words into action. It will be difficult, but if we are truly joyful, there is no need for anxiety, worry or fear. Jesus is our mighty savior and, as the word implies, Emmanuel has come to save us! Rejoice and do not be afraid, for Christ is in our midst. Let us awake from our slumber and find peace in our faith!

Jubilee Year

Pope Francis has designated the Jubilee of Hope, a Holy Year, to begin on Dec. 29, 2024 and end Dec. 28, 2025. The Pope wants the coming Jubilee Year 2025 to be lived as a year of hope, which is very symbolic in times when the world's wars seem to be unending and multiplying.

Most of the Jubilee Year events will occur in Rome. For pilgrims who cannot travel to Rome, bishops are expected to designate sites as special places of prayer for Holy Year pilgrims, offering opportunities for reconciliation, indulgences and other events intended to strengthen and revive faith.



St. Michael has been designated a Jubilee Pilgrimage Site. This is truly an honor for us. As part of the observance of the Jubilee Year, Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence. One of the means for obtaining the Indulgence is that the faithful make a pilgrimage to a parish or shrine designated as a Jubilee Pilgrimage Site. At these sites, the faithful experience and obtain the indulgence by spending time in prayer, adoration before the tabernacle, or participating in the celebration of the Eucharist or Reconciliation (as well as by making a profession of faith and praying for the Holy Father's intentions). You will have many opportunities to obtain the plenary indulgence just by coming to your parish home. Let us listen to the Holy Father and commit to living 2025 in hope.

I invite you to pray often the Jubilee Prayer:

*Father in heaven,
may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother,
and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit,
reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.*

May your grace transform us into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel.

*May those seeds transform from within both humanity and
the whole cosmos in sure expectation of a new heaven and a new earth,
when with the powers of Evil vanquished, your glory will shine eternally.*

*May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope,
a yearning for the treasures of heaven.*

May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth.

To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen.




Hey, Kids! "Lamb Of God" Gift Basket Raffle

El Espíritu del Padre Frank

En la segunda lectura de hoy, San Pablo nos dice: “*No se preocupen por nada*”. Obviamente, San Pablo no se da cuenta de que faltan solo 10 días para Navidad. Muchas personas están llenas de ansiedad esta semana. Estamos tratando de terminar nuestras tarjetas navideñas y las compras navideñas. ¿Qué es otro viaje al centro comercial con las multitudes y el tráfico que presionan? Necesitamos asegurarnos de que nuestras casas estén decoradas adecuadamente y que nuestra cena navideña esté planeada y comprada. ¿No tienen ansiedad? Por favor, estamos llenos de ansiedad y preocupación.

Las palabras de Juan el Bautista en el evangelio de hoy deberían causarnos ansiedad a todos: “*Su aventador está en su mano, y limpiará su era, y recogerá el trigo en su granero, y quemará la paja en fuego que nunca se apagará.*” Una vez más, las Escrituras nos recuerdan un día de juicio y una separación de los buenos de los malos. Se nos da la oportunidad de examinar nuestras vidas y hacer los cambios necesarios para asegurarnos de que estamos viviendo de la manera que Jesús nos enseñó.

La gente le preguntó a Juan: “*¿Qué debemos hacer?*” Su respuesta no sólo estaba dirigida a ellos, sino a nosotros. Lo que debemos hacer es amarnos unos a otros, cuidarnos unos a otros y perdonarnos unos a otros. Donde hay amor, compasión y perdón, Dios está presente.

Este domingo es el *domingo de Gaudete*, que significa Regocijo. La vela rosa de la corona de Adviento está encendida y el círculo de luz está casi completo. El profeta Sofonías nos llama a regocijarnos y a no desanimarnos porque Dios está en medio de nosotros. Sí, nos regocijamos, porque sabemos que Emmanuel ha venido: Dios con nosotros.

El Adviento es una de esas temporadas extrañas en las que nos preparamos para la venida de Cristo. Reconocemos que Jesús ya nació en el tiempo, por lo que nos preparamos para su venida a nuestros corazones, vidas y mundo de nuevo en esta Navidad. Cuando Cristo es el centro de nuestras vidas, el resto encaja en su lugar y en la perspectiva adecuada. También debemos prepararnos para la venida de Jesús en gloria. Debemos prepararnos para el juicio viviendo la vida de un hijo de Dios. Si no ha aprovechado el Sacramento de la Reconciliación durante un tiempo, le insto a que lo haga. ¿Qué mejor manera de prepararnos para la venida de Cristo que estar libres del pecado? Se escucharán confesiones el sábado 21 de diciembre, de 3:00 a 4:00 p.m.

Así pues, alegrémonos este fin de semana y tratemos de poner en práctica las palabras de San Pablo. Será difícil, pero si estamos verdaderamente alegres, no hay necesidad de ansiedad, preocupación o miedo. Jesús es nuestro poderoso salvador; como lo implica la palabra, ¡Emmanuel ha venido a salvarnos! Alegremos y no tengamos miedo, porque Cristo está en medio de nosotros. ¡Despertemos de nuestro letargo y encontraremos paz en nuestra fe!

Año del Jubileo

El Papa Francisco ha designado el Jubileo de la Esperanza, un Año Santo que comenzará el 29 de diciembre de 2024 y terminará el 28 de diciembre de 2025. El Papa quiere que el próximo Año Jubilar de 2025 se viva como un año de esperanza, muy simbólico en tiempos en los que las guerras del mundo parecen no tener fin y se están multiplicando.

La mayoría de los eventos del Año Jubilar se llevarán a cabo en Roma. Para los peregrinos que no puedan viajar a Roma, se espera que los obispos designen sitios especiales de oración para los peregrinos del Año Santo, ofreciendo oportunidades de reconciliación, indulgencias y otros eventos destinados a fortalecer y reavivar la fe.

San Miguel ha sido designado como Lugar de Peregrinación Jubilar. Esto es realmente un honor para nosotros. Como parte de la celebración del Año Jubilar, el Papa Francisco ha otorgado una indulgencia plenaria. Uno de los medios para obtener la indulgencia es que los fieles hagan una peregrinación a una parroquia o santuario designado como Lugar de Peregrinación Jubilar.
