John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, “Behold, the Lamb of God.” The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. - Jn 1:35-36

Father Frank's Fire

The Christmas trees, lights, wreaths and crèche have been taken down and stored away. We once again enter Ordinary Time – the vestments are green – reminding us that God is present in the ordinary events in our lives.

Today's gospel focuses our attention on the call of the first disciples. Jesus asks us the same question that he asked his first followers, *"What are you looking for?"* An interesting question, and did you ever wonder how you would respond? Imagine Jesus looking you right in the eyes – his face filled with gentleness, compassion, understanding and love. What are we really looking for? I suspect that we are looking for joy and happiness, fulfillment and a meaningful life. As humans, we search here and there to find joy and happiness, and often we miss the obvious – all of these and more are present in Christ Jesus. We do not have to look far – Christ is here. To the first disciples Jesus says, *"Come and you will see."* This same invitation is open to us. We are invited to be disciples. Are you willing to follow where Christ will lead you? Are you willing to stop searching for joy in the wrong places? Let us listen to Jesus whispering in our ears, *"Come and you will see."* Come into the presence of God and you will finally find what you are looking for.

Andrew's joy was overwhelming. It was contagious and he had to share this good news. He went to Simon (Peter) and said, *"We have found the Messiah."* We too have found the Messiah, the One who brings us salvation. We do not seem to have the same enthusiasm as the first disciples. Perhaps our attitude is one of indifference. If only we could realize the great gift that we have among us, and we, too, would be filled with joy. We should have the same courage to shout from our rooftops that Christ is among us. Our salvation is here – we have been saved from sin and death. Let us rejoice and share with the world these simple words, *"We have found the Messiah."*

Taking Home the Sunday Scriptures 2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time January 14, 2024

In today's scripture, Samuel is sleeping in the temple of the Lord. How many times do we hear a voice or have a feeling that something is happening, or someone is calling us, but we do not know who it is, or why we are being aroused from our slumber? Nor do we acknowledge the calling. Could it be God calling out to us? Let's pay attention!

We may go back to sleep, over and over, without even trying to figure out why God might be calling us. Do we respond to God's call or just go right back to sleep? Or, do we give in and say, like Samuel did, "Speak, for your servant is listening"? What might God be telling us in this day and age?

In today's gospel, John recognizes Jesus as he walks by and acknowledges who Jesus really is . . . The Lamb of God. John, Peter and Andrew acknowledge this wonderful gift and willingly follow the Lord.

Jesus is still in our midst today, calling out to us. Sometimes we hear his voice . . . and many times we do not! Sometimes we forget that our lives have been ransomed by Christ. Remember, Jesus gave his very life so that we could live forever. Are we appreciative? Or do we fall back to sleep and ignore his call?

Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." This is something that John the Baptist said when he saw Jesus walking toward him. It puts a smile on my face to imagine this.

John says that he did not know who Jesus was when he saw him. Yet, he said this wonderful thing about him that was so nice. *He takes away the sin of the world.*

It says in the Gospel that the Spirit came down on Jesus and, because of this, John knew he was the Son of God. Imagine you being John for a second. Think about how it would feel to see someone walking toward you, and you see this light surround them and you feel peace and love. Not only do you see and feel these things, but the person you are looking at is your gift to salvation and the One that will teach us all how to take away the sins of the world.

What does it mean to take away the sins of the world? It means that Jesus was going to show us how to behave. He wasn't going to use some powerful sword or lightening strike to change our behaviors. Jesus was sent to SHOW and TELL us how to respect one another. Each of us is in control of what we do. God does not direct us from heaven like puppets. God sent us Jesus so that we can learn from Him.

John the Baptist had a lot of love for God. He spoke about what he knew of Him and baptized people in order to please Him. However, John knew that he was not the Messiah and often told people that someone else greater than him would come to save us. So, when Jesus was walking towards John, he saw his hero coming towards him.

Have you ever had that experience where you see someone you love come towards you? Perhaps it was a good friend or relative you haven't seen in a while. You may get up and jump for joy at the sight of them! That is how John felt. He knew Jesus was going to save us and our world would forever change because of what we would learn from Him.

Each time you read a story in the bible, go to church or learn about Jesus, you are being filled with God's light. Each time you react with love instead of in anger, you are taking away the sins of the world. You must try hard to fulfill God's wishes by acting kindly each and every day. Live your life like Jesus and rejoice for him like St. John the Baptist.

Let's pray: Heavenly Father, thank you for sending us your Son. Help us to always remember that we have the power to not be sinful. Amen.

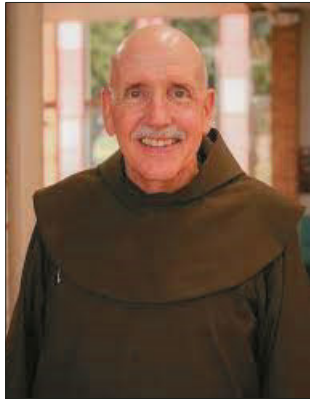

El Espíritu del Padre Frank

Los árboles de Navidad, las luces, las coronas y el pesebre han sido desmontados y guardados. Una vez más entramos en el Tiempo Ordinario, las vestiduras son verdes, recordándonos que Dios está presente en los acontecimientos ordinarios de nuestras vidas.

El evangelio de hoy enfoca nuestra atención en el llamado de los primeros discípulos. Jesús nos hace la misma pregunta que les hizo a sus primeros seguidores: “¿*Qué buscáis?*” Una pregunta interesante. ¿Alguna vez te has preguntado cómo responderías? Imagina a Jesús mirándote directamente a los ojos: su rostro lleno de gentileza, compasión, comprensión y amor. ¿Qué estamos buscando realmente? Sospecho que buscamos alegría y felicidad, plenitud y una vida con sentido. Como seres humanos, buscamos aquí y allá para encontrar gozo y felicidad y, a menudo, perdemos lo obvio: todo esto y más está presente en Cristo Jesús. No tenemos que mirar muy lejos: Cristo está aquí. A los primeros discípulos Jesús les dice: “*Ven y lo verás.*” Esta misma invitación está abierta para nosotros. Estamos invitados a ser discípulos. ¿Estás dispuesto a seguir a donde Cristo te llevará? ¿Estás dispuesto a dejar de buscar la alegría en los lugares equivocados? Escuchemos a Jesús susurrando al oído: “*Ven y lo verás.*” Ven a la presencia de Dios y finalmente encontrarás lo que buscas.



La alegría de Andrés fue abrumadora. Era contagiosa y tenía que compartir esta buena noticia. Fue donde Simón (Pedro) y le dijo: “*Hemos encontrado al Mesías*”. Nosotros también hemos encontrado al Mesías, Aquel que nos trae la salvación. Sin embargo, no parecemos tener el mismo entusiasmo que los primeros discípulos. Quizás nuestra actitud sea de indiferencia. Si tan solo pudiéramos darnos cuenta del gran regalo que tenemos entre nosotros, tal vez también nos llenaríamos de alegría. Deberíamos tener el mismo valor para gritar a los cuatro vientos que Cristo está entre nosotros. Nuestra salvación está aquí: hemos sido salvados del pecado y de la muerte. Alegrémonos y compartamos con el mundo estas sencillas palabras: “Hemos encontrado al Mesías.”

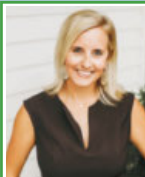

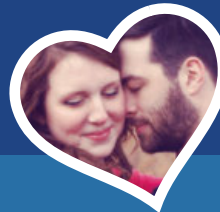
