Father Frank's Fire

In today's gospel we hear the call of the first disciples. I find it amazing that the first disciples abandoned everything — family, jobs and homes — to follow Jesus. There must have been something that caused them to place all their faith, hope and future in this man from Galilee.

We, too, have been invited by Jesus to follow him. While we may not be asked to leave our families, Jesus does ask us to leave behind our former ways of living. Society tells us that work, possessions, status and popularity are important. Jesus tells us that these are secondary and what is important is our relationship with Him. Where do you wish to cast your net? We can do so with society and, after chasing all the luxuries of the world, we will find ourselves tired, alone and empty. On the other hand, we can cast our nets with Jesus, and after a lifetime of prayer and service, we will find ourselves fulfilled, joyful and at peace because we followed in the footsteps of the Master. The choice is ours but make no mistake about it – our decision has eternal consequences.

Anniversary

January 22 marks the 51st anniversary of the United States Supreme Court's decision on Roe v. Wade. This decision has led to legalizing abortion in the United States. This decision marked the beginning of a dark period for people of faith.

On June 24, 2022, the United States Supreme Court overturned the Roe v. Wade decision that made access to an abortion a federal right in the United States. People of faith rejoiced but this decision did not end abortion. This decision allows the various States to pass their own laws. This can be considered a victory for Respect Life Advocates, but it is a victory in a battle – there is still work to be done.

There are many who have suffered emotional scars because of an abortion. The Archdiocese of Chicago offers a program called Project Rachel that helps those suffering from the emotional and spiritual scars of abortion. This program is confidential and free. Project Rachel provides post-abortion healing for mothers, fathers, grandparents and others. Through this program the Church reaches out and offers

Taking Home the Sunday Scriptures 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time January 21, 2024

St. Paul reminds his readers that the world in its present form is passing away. He and his readers are expecting Jesus to return right away. The second coming of Christ does not seem as imminent for us today as it did for the early Christians. We have already been waiting for over 2,000 years! But in the gospel Jesus proclaims that *this is* the time of fulfillment and that the kingdom of God *is* at hand.

Jesus is not speaking only to the people of his day, but to us, too. However, with all of the violence and mess in our world, we find it hard to believe that a new heaven and a new earth are very near . . . or that we can do anything about it. But our faith reassures us that God's kingdom is already in our midst right now. We see bits and pieces of God's kingdom in the loving words and actions of God's people, and we look forward to a time of unending peace, love and joy for all people.

Both the first reading and the gospel call believers to be sorry for their wrongdoing. They are called to change their ways. In a few short weeks, Lent will begin, with its call to "Repent and believe in the gospel." As we look for Christ's presence in our midst this week, let's look first at our own lives, change what is not Christ-like and reaffirm our belief that God's kingdom is at hand. With Christ, we play an important part in kingdom-building.

- Where do I see God's kingdom? How can I grow the Kingdom?
- What must I abandon in my life to follow Jesus?
- How will I get ready to enter into Lent?

When was the last time you were busy doing something. Then someone called you to do something else, and you willingly stopped what you were doing to answer their call?

I know in my house, it takes a few attempts to get my family's attention...and then maybe a threatening tone to my voice to REALLY get them moving. It's hard to just stop doing something that we are working on. If we stop, it may prevent us from completing whatever it is that we were working on. If we are having fun, it is even harder to stop what we are doing to do something else.

Whenever I read this story in the Gospel of Mark, I am always amazed at how the men stopped fishing to follow Jesus. They didn't argue with Jesus about where they were going or why they needed to stop. They just obeyed him. Fishing was how they earned a living and how they kept from being hungry. Jesus asking them to stop fishing was something that would change their lives completely. These men fished for food to survive. Jesus was telling them to stop doing that so that they could help him teach others about God – and they obeyed! That is pretty amazing if you ask me. This story tells us that these men had complete faith in Jesus. They did not question what he asked them to do, because they knew He had everything that they needed.

It may be hard to believe, but Jesus calls us each day to stop what we are doing and pray. Before we dig into our delicious meals, take a hard test at school or get tucked in at night, Jesus is asking us to STOP and pray. He calls us to STOP and lend a helping hand. He wants us to practice our faith, but also to STOP and talk about it with others. Maybe you have friends who just celebrated Christmas but never go to Mass? This would be a good time to invite them to start attending Mass. Tell them to start going to church now, so that on Christmas 2024, their hearts and minds will be prepared for Jesus.

When we invite others to be a part of our Christian faith, we are being fishers of men! That means we are bringing in people so they can fully know the Word of God and share in His Supper. Wouldn't it be great to help a friend to find God's grace? I believe that Jesus has called us ALL to help him spread the Word of God! Let this year be a time of "fulfillment"!

Let's pray: Dear Jesus, help us to know what we can do to be fishermen and fisherwomen who reel in people for the kingdom of heaven! Amen.




