THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken
up to heaven. - Lk 24:51

Father Frank's Fire

Happy Easter! We have one more week to celebrate Easter. Today we celebrate the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. When I was growing up, Ascension Thursday was celebrated 40 days after Easter – it was always a Thursday – and was a Holy Day of Obligation. Several decades ago, the Bishops of the United States decided to move the Solemnity of the Ascension to the Seventh Sunday of Easter, and that is why we celebrate the Ascension this weekend and not on Thursday.

Sometimes we just do not get it. No matter how hard we try, we just cannot seem to understand. I must admit that for most of my life I did not understand the significance of the Ascension. I thought, “What’s the big deal?” Jesus tells us that in order for the Holy Spirit to come – He must return to the Father in heaven. When I was young, I did not understand the power and the importance of the Holy Spirit’s presence and action in the world. For without the Holy Spirit – we can do nothing. The Holy Spirit gives us the courage and strength to live and share our faith.

After Jesus ascended into heaven, his disciples stood there looking into the sky. Why? The answer is simple, they did not understand – they did not know what to do. The angels said, “*Why are you standing there looking into the sky?*” To put it another way – do not just stand there; there is something that you have to do – now go and do it! In the gospel, they were given a mission, “*Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature.*” It was not until the Holy Spirit came that they understood the importance of their mission. However, once the Spirit descended upon them, they went out with courage and vigor, and proclaimed the Good News to anyone who would listen. We know that they were successful, for here we are thousands of years later and thousands of miles from Jerusalem, and **We Believe** in the saving power and love of Christ.

It seems to me that we are like the first disciples standing around and looking into the air. We also have a mission to tell the world of God’s love for us. We are called to share our faith with those around us. Sometimes we are afraid because we do not want to be made fun of. Jesus invites us to let go of our fears and to do the work he has entrusted us to do.

May this Pentecost breathe fire, life and renewal in our lives and in the life of the Church. Let our prayer be a simple one, “Come Holy Spirit Come!”

Instead of coming to the priest and asking for a prayer sometime in the future, the prayer teams will be available after Masses to offer prayer with the asker. Did you ever watch a balloon float up into the sky? It's a fun thing to watch a balloon ascend into the sky. Today we hear about the Ascension of Jesus into heaven — of when Jesus died, rose from the dead and then he ascended into heaven after 40 days. Jesus ascended into the clouds and went to heaven. Ascension is a big word but Jesus deserves a big word since he did a pretty amazing thing!

Imagine that Jesus' friends saw this marvelous thing occur. They probably did not want to see him go because they loved and cared for him so much. Close your eyes and try and imagine what it would be like to see Jesus ascend into heaven. What would you feel? How would you react in seeing him float into the sky like a balloon and disappear into the clouds?

His friends were probably very emotional and crying happy tears, sad tears and tears of joy. They knew they were following the right man, but they were in awe to see him leave them in such a fantastic way. They knew if they continued their work for God, they would go into heaven just like Jesus did. They knew that even though Jesus ascended into heaven, he is still with us. Jesus is in church, the Eucharist, the sacraments and in all the people around you.

Remember that Jesus is always with you. Know that when you believe in him, you too, will live forever in heaven.

Let's pray: Heavenly Father, we know that Jesus promised us eternal life in heaven. Please help us to forgive those that hurt us and love one another the way that Jesus taught us, so that we can have eternal life in heaven. Amen.

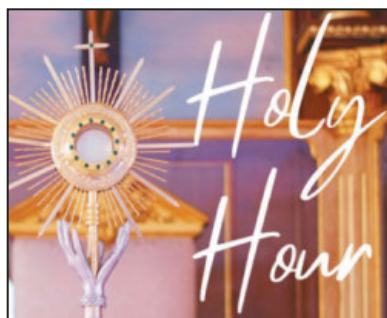

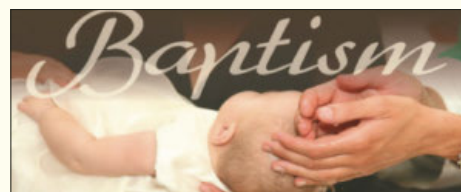

El Espíritu del Padre Frank

¡Felices Pascuas! Nos queda una semana más para celebrar la Pascua. Hoy celebramos la Ascensión de Jesús al cielo. De niño, el Jueves de la Ascensión se celebraba cuarenta días después de Pascua (siempre era jueves) y era un día de precepto. Hace varias décadas, los obispos de Estados Unidos decidieron trasladar la Solemnidad de la Ascensión al Séptimo Domingo de Pascua, y por eso celebramos la Ascensión este fin de semana y no el jueves.

A veces simplemente no lo entendemos. Por mucho que lo intentemos, parece que no logramos comprenderlo. Debo admitir que durante la mayor parte de mi vida no comprendí el significado de la Ascensión. Pensaba: "¿Por qué tanta importancia?" Jesús nos dice que para que el Espíritu Santo venga, debe regresar al Padre celestial. De joven, no entendía el poder ni la importancia de la presencia y la acción del Espíritu Santo en el mundo. Porque sin el Espíritu Santo, nada podemos hacer. El Espíritu Santo nos da la valentía y la fuerza para vivir y compartir nuestra fe.

Después de que Jesús ascendió al cielo, sus discípulos se quedaron mirando al firmamento. ¿Por qué? La respuesta es sencilla: no entendieron, no sabían qué hacer. Los ángeles les dijeron: "*¿Por qué están ahí mirando al cielo?*" Dicho de otro modo: no se queden ahí parados; hay algo que deben hacer: ¡ahora vayan y háganlo! En el Evangelio, se les encomendó una misión: "*Vayan por todo el mundo y anuncien el evangelio a toda criatura.*" No fue hasta que vino el Espíritu Santo que comprendieron la importancia de su misión. Sin embargo, una vez que el Espíritu descendió sobre ellos, salieron con valentía y vigor a proclamar la Buena Nueva a todo aquel que quisiera escucharlos. Sabemos que tuvieron éxito, porque aquí estamos, miles de años después, y a miles de millas de Jerusalén, y **Creemos** en el poder salvador y el amor de Cristo.

Me parece que somos como los primeros discípulos que estaban de pie, mirando al cielo. También tenemos la misión de anunciar al mundo el amor de Dios por nosotros. Estamos llamados a compartir nuestra fe con quienes nos rodean. A veces tenemos miedo porque no queremos que se burlen de nosotros. Jesús nos invita a dejar atrás nuestros miedos y a hacer la obra que nos ha encomendado.

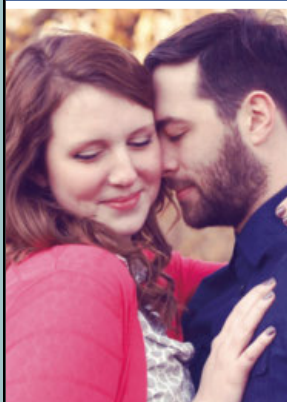
