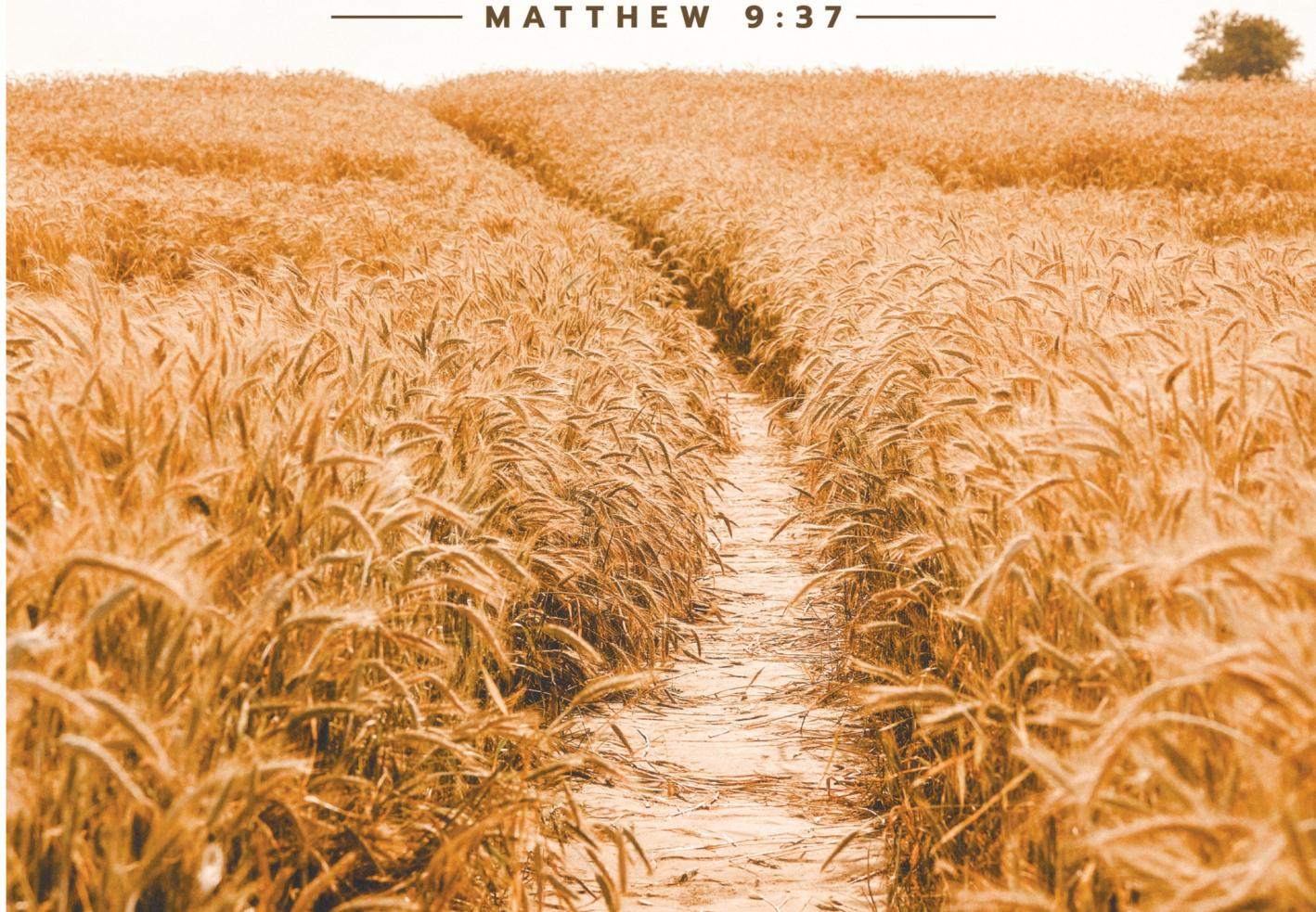

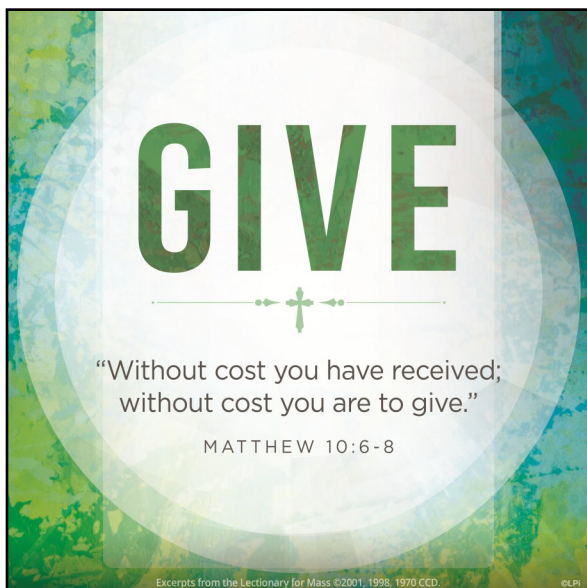

FR. FRANK'S FIRE



Sometimes the words of the Gospel are telling of how Jesus feels about us. *“At the sight of the crowds, Jesus’ heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned.”* Now I do not know about you, but I do not like to be pitied. There is something almost demeaning when someone pities someone else. Yet this is not the message of the Gospel today – I do not believe that Jesus’ heart was filled with the pity we are used to, but instead his heart was filled with love. Jesus was filled with strong emotions because those in charge of the spiritual needs of the people were failing greatly.

The good news is that Jesus is the Good Shepherd of the lost and he desires to lead those who have gone astray to return to him. Jesus seeks out those that have been cast off by society, those that feel abandoned, and those fearful because of their sins.

Jesus was not one to just sit by and watch with pity. No, he called the twelve disciples and he called them by name. As soon as Jesus gathered his disciples, he instructed them and sent them out into the world. The same process continues today in the Church. Men and women are formed into their faith and once prepared they are sent out to go and make a difference. Who is called to do this? All of us! We have each received this great gift of faith and now we are asked to share it with others. The sharing of the faith is not just the responsibility of the priests, sisters, deacons, and other professional ministers. The responsibility of sharing the faith rests with each and every one of us. *“Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.”* May we have the courage to share our faith with one another.

Retreat for Widows & Widowers

I wanted to let you know about a wonderful opportunity for those of you who are widows and widowers. Beginning on Saturday, June 27 and ending on Sunday, June 28, there will be a retreat at St. Julie Billiard Parish just for you. The retreat is called Joyful Again! The retreat is facilitated by others who have lost their spouses, by people who understand your grief. It is designed to help widowed individuals, with God’s help, move through bereavement toward spiritual and emotional wholeness. Priest Convocation

The following is a message from the Office of the Vicar General:

Priests serving in the Archdiocese of Chicago will gather for their biennial convocation from June 15 through June 18. This gathering is an important and necessary time of spiritual renewal for the priests, so that they can better serve the People of God.

The priests have been asked to clear their schedules, so that they can fully participate in this experience. Consequently, during those four days, there might not be weekday Masses celebrated in some parishes. However, there will be prayer services to be determined by each parish.

Even more important is the prayerful support they extend to priests who have prayed for them and with them. Through the prayers of the Blessed Virgin Mary, draw all priests and the flocks entrusted to their care to the fullness of eternal life where you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

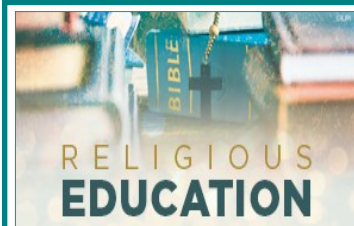

Ahora bien, no sé ustedes, pero a mí no me gusta que me tengan lástima. Hay algo casi humillante en que alguien sienta lástima por otra persona. Sin embargo, este no es el mensaje del evangelio de hoy; no creo que el corazón de Jesús estuviera lleno de la lástima a la que estamos acostumbrados, sino que, por el contrario, su corazón estaba lleno de amor. Jesús estaba lleno de fuertes emociones porque aquellos que estaban a cargo de las necesidades espirituales del pueblo estaban fallando gravemente.

La buena noticia es que Jesús es el buen pastor de los perdidos y desea guiar a quienes se han extraviado para que regresen a Él. Jesús busca a aquellos que han sido marginados por la sociedad, a los que se sienten abandonados y a los que temen a causa de sus pecados.

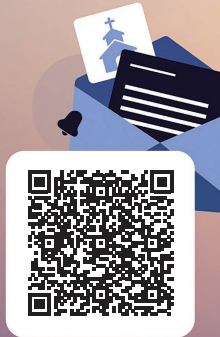

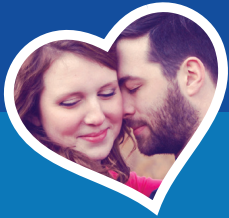

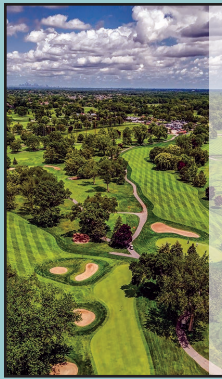
