Father Frank's Fire

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The mystery of the Trinity is indeed difficult to understand and has kept theologians and preachers busy for centuries. Our faith tells us that there is ONE God, revealed to us as three persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We are invited to get a glimpse at the inner life of God today. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit share all and are One, united in love. The gospel reminds us that Jesus has much more to tell, but the disciples cannot bear it now. The disciples must wait for the Holy Spirit to lead and to guide them. It is the same Spirit that leads and guides us today. Let us open our hearts to the Spirit's promptings so that we can be guided in knowledge and truth. Today let us enter into the mystery of the Trinity by realizing that God is One and that God calls us to unity and love.

Here is the Collect of this weekend's Masses which helps us to understand what the Church believes about the Trinity:

God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty.

Though our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever. AMEN!

Happy Father's Day! Today is a day that we honor our fathers both living and deceased. On this day, we honor not only our biological fathers, but all those men who have had a significant influence in our lives. In addition to my own father, I have several mentors and role models who have and continue to shape and influence my life. We are taught that whenever we are going to pray, we should bless ourselves by saying, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." We may get

confused with this wonderful mystery of faith. How can God be Jesus and then also be a Spirit? I am sure the disciples were also confused when Jesus told them that the "Spirit of truth" will guide them.

Before Jesus died on the cross, he started to prepare his disciples for what was to come. He told them that after he is gone, the Spirit of truth would guide them. Today, we believe that his promise is true for all of us. The Holy Spirit can guide us to do what is right. It can guide us to use our talents to help other people. It can guide us to be empathetic or understand someone when they may not be on their best behavior. It can help calm us when we are upset, anxious or feeling like we are lost.

God is our creator. He created all things. Everything around us is made by God. God created US! However, God wanted us to understand that He was like us, He sent us Jesus to show us how to live, love and respect one another. Jesus was human like you and me; except that he was perfect in every way. Jesus needed to leave this world, but God wanted us to understand that even though Jesus would not be here on earth, He would still live within us through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit lives within each one of us. The Holy Spirit is God; it is Jesus' teachings.

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity that we celebrate today is a great mystery of God. It is important for us to understand that Jesus is always with us. It can be very hard to feel His presence when there is so much sadness around us. I do talk to God, and I ask Him, "Where are you? Why are these horrible things happening?" I feel that He tells me to focus on Him., continue to do His work and spread the Word. This may seem like a simple task However, truly think about it. Do you think the people that are stealing, killing, lying or hurting other people are following Jesus? I don't think they are; I think they are lost. So I will pray for them to find Jesus. I will pray for the Holy Spirit to guide them to change their behavior. They say that a kind gesture goes a long way. Remember that when you are out and about to smile at people, open doors and do kind gestures. Your smile and kind heart may be exactly what a wounded heart needs.

Let's Pray: Dear God, help my prayers reach those that need it the most. Help me spread the Word of God to all those I encounter. In Jesus' name, Amen!





- All of us parents, grandparents, single persons, college students, or high school students and even children.






