FR. FRANK'S FIRE

The early Church was a persecuted Church. Persecution confronted them from various sides. These harsh threats proved to be too much for many to handle and they walked away from the faith. The Roman government persecuted them, as well as many of the Jewish religious leaders. St. Matthew realizes that these threats are real, serious and dangerous but tries to assure his readers that faith-filled followers of disciples can withstand the threats of death and death itself.

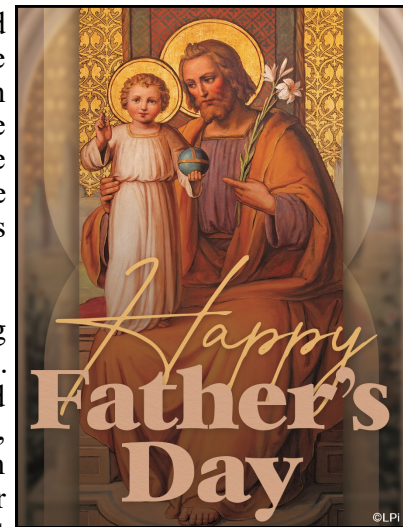
The call of discipleship requires courage and we are not to be afraid. Fear is a powerful motivator that many use to get their way, and yet Jesus reminds us that what truly matters is our souls. “Do not be afraid of those who kill the body, but cannot kill the soul.” This is difficult to hear, as many are afraid of death, especially death by violence. Jesus reminded us not to be afraid of physical death, but to be afraid of losing our relationship with God and hence – the heavenly Kingdom. Matthew also reminds us how much God cares for us. If God cares for the birds, how much more will he care for us, as we are more important than sparrows.

It seems that things have not really changed over the years. The Church is still being persecuted from many sides, by non-believers and believers. There are internal and external threats. They promote false narratives and even lies to instill fear into the hearts of faithful followers of Jesus. Jesus demands that while these treats are real, we must have courage and strength and never stop giving witness to God. Jesus lays it on the line rather clearly, “But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father.” Yes, being a disciple is not easy and it can be dangerous. Let us pray for strength and courage to face the difficulties we encounter. While it may not be easy, the rewards are eternal and so are the consequences. The choice is ours.

Father's Day

Happy Father's Day! Today is a day that we honor our fathers both living and deceased. On this day, we honor not only our biological fathers, but also all the men who have had a significant influence in our lives. In addition to my own father, I have several mentors and role models who have and continue to shape and influence my life. Sometimes Dads get a bad rap because often they are the ones who have to do the discipline in the family. One of my mother's favorite sayings was, “Wait till your father gets home.” I have to admit that those words always put a little fear in me.

I have been ordained a priest for twenty-eight years and I still find it amusing that my title is “Father” and yet I do not have any children of my own. Although it is easier today, as I am a little older and I could actually be Grand Father Frank! While I am not a father caring for the physical needs of children, I care for the spiritual and temporal needs of the parish. I am aware that I am not perfect and sometimes I made mistakes and decisions that have hurt or alienated others. The responsibility that is entrusted to me is overwhelming at times. I am humbled by your care and support.



Today offer a prayer for all those who have played a father's role in your life. Remember that no one is perfect, not even our fathers. Sometimes they make mistakes – perhaps today is a day to forgive.

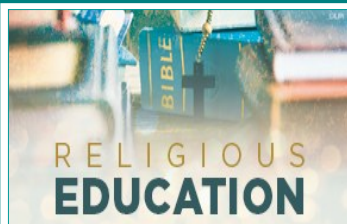

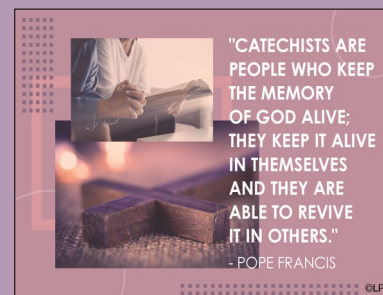

EL ESPIRITU DE PADRE FRANK

La Iglesia primitiva fue una Iglesia perseguida. La persecución provenía de diversos frentes. Estas duras amenazas resultaron insoportables para muchos, quienes terminaron abandonando la fe. Tanto el gobierno romano como muchos líderes religiosos judíos los perseguían. San Mateo reconoce que estas amenazas son reales, graves y peligrosas, pero intenta asegurar a sus lectores que los discípulos llenos de fe pueden resistir tales amenazas de muerte, e incluso la muerte misma.

La llamada al discipulado exige valentía, y no debemos tener miedo. El miedo es un poderoso instrumento que muchos utilizan para salirse con la suya; sin embargo, Jesús nos recuerda que lo que verdaderamente importa son nuestras almas. *“No teman a los que matan el cuerpo, pero no pueden matar el alma.”* Estas palabras son difíciles de asimilar, pues muchos temen a la muerte, especialmente a una muerte violenta. Jesús nos recordó que no debemos temer a la muerte física, sino a perder nuestra relación con Dios y, por ende, el Reino de los cielos. Mateo también nos recuerda cuánto se preocupa Dios por nosotros. Si Dios cuida de las aves, cuánto más cuidará de nosotros, ya que valemos más que los gorriones.

Parece que las cosas no han cambiado realmente con el paso de los años. La Iglesia sigue siendo perseguida desde muchos frentes, tanto por no creyentes como por creyentes. Existen amenazas tanto internas como externas. Se difunden narrativas falsas e incluso mentiras para infundir temor en los corazones de los fieles seguidores de Jesús. Jesús nos exige que, aunque estas amenazas sean reales, tengamos valentía y fortaleza, y que nunca dejemos de dar testimonio de Dios. Jesús lo plantea con total claridad: *“Pero a quien me niegue ante los demás, yo también lo negaré ante mi Padre celestial”*. Sí, ser discípulo no es fácil y puede resultar peligroso. Oremos para recibir la fortaleza y el valor necesarios para afrontar las dificultades que encontremos. Aunque no sea tarea fácil, las recompensas son eternas, al igual que las consecuencias. La elección es nuestra.

Día del Padre

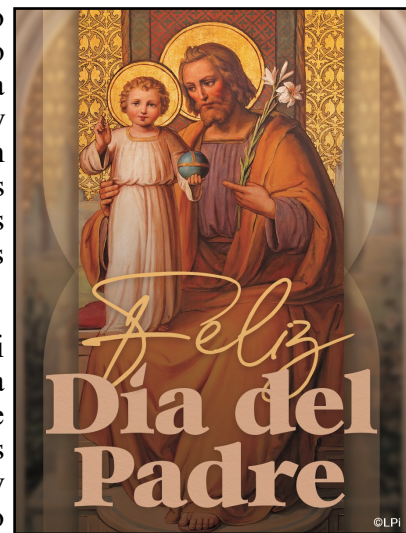

Aunque ahora, con la edad, es más fácil, ¡podría ser el abuelo Frank! Si bien no soy un padre que se ocupa de las necesidades físicas de los niños, me ocupo de las necesidades espirituales y temporales de la parroquia. Soy consciente de que no soy perfecto y que a veces cometo errores y tomo decisiones que han herido o alejado a otros. La responsabilidad que se me confía a veces es abrumadora. Me siento profundamente agradecido por su cariño y apoyo.

Hoy, elevemos una oración por todos aquellos que han desempeñado un papel paterno en nuestras vidas. Recordemos que nadie es perfecto, ni siquiera nuestros padres. A veces se equivocan; quizás hoy sea un buen día para perdonar.

Mensajes más emotivos del Pape Leon en su visita a España

- “La caridad no admite demoras”, una frase que resume su llamado a actuar con urgencia ante el sufrimiento.
- “Las palabras pueden abrir caminos o cerrarlos”, subrayando que el lenguaje público debe humanizar y no dividir.
- “La paz exige valentía diplomática”, un mensaje muy citado de su discurso en España sobre resolver conflictos con responsabilidad ética.
- En la misa de Cibeles, pidió que la religiosidad no sea “un museo del pasado”, sino una “escuela de fe” viva y transformadora.
- También insistió en salir de una fe cómoda y privada para convertirse en “constructores de un mundo nuevo”.

Su tono más emotivo fue cuando vinculó la fe con la vida real: familias, ancianos, enfermos, jóvenes, migrantes y personas heridas por la violencia o la indiferencia. También resultó especialmente fuerte su idea de que la política y la convivencia deben cuidar la palabra para no degradar al otro. En conjunto, el mensaje fue una invitación a compasión, reconciliación y responsabilidad pública.

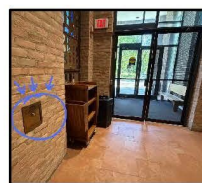
- Food, toiletries and household products from our food pantry;
