

FR. FRANK'S FIRE



In today's gospel, Jesus transfigured before Peter, James and John. His garments became dazzling white and Jesus changed before their eyes. On the mountain, Jesus showed his disciples his glory. 



La Virgen de los Ángeles es la patrona de Costa Rica, conocida cariñosamente como "La Negrita" por el color oscuro de su pequeña imagen.

Historia

Según la tradición, el 2 de agosto de 1635, una joven indígena llamada Juana Pereira encontró una pequeña imagen de la Virgen María sobre una piedra en el lugar donde hoy está la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de los Ángeles, en Cartago.

Cada vez que intentaba llevársela a su casa, la imagen regresaba misteriosamente al mismo sitio, interpretándose como un signo de que la Virgen quería que allí se construyera un templo.

Miles de peregrinos caminan (la famosa romería) desde diferentes partes del país hasta la Basílica en Cartago.






