“This son of mine was dead, and has
come to life again.” - Lk 15:24a

Father Frank's Fire

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Where has the time gone? The Fourth Sunday of Lent is known as *Laetare Sunday*. *Laetare* simple means rejoice. This Sunday sets a tone of joyful anticipation of the Easter mystery, as does the Rose vestments that are worn this weekend.

One of my favorite gospels is the story of the prodigal child. Each time I read this passage, I gain a new insight. There is a lot to this reading. I think we like to identify with the prodigal child. We have sometimes lost our way, made some mistakes and then we come to our senses, repent and are forgiven. This gives us a warm and fuzzy feeling. Did you ever wonder if you were more like the other child? The other child's anger and jealousy prevents him from entering the party, the celebration, the Kingdom. He is so consumed with zeal and righteousness that he is blinded to forgiveness and compassion. We probably do not want to admit it, but I think there is some of "the other" child in each of us.

The real story is about the father – who watches and waits for his son to return. He is not concerned with apologies or explanations – but is ready to forgive and to celebrate. Did you know that the word *prodigal* means recklessly extravagant? Not only does this describe the one son's lifestyle, but it also describes the father's love and forgiveness. We are called to be more like the father and be reckless with forgiveness. Could you imagine what our world would be like if we were all willing to forgive? Let us take a lesson from today's gospel and be *extravagant* with our faith!

One of my favorite movies is “The Wizard of Oz.” I love the music, singing, dancing and overall story. It’s about a girl named Dorothy who runs away from home because she thinks there is more to be seen out there in the big world. There are lots of great things about this story. However, after encountering a witch, some flying monkeys and a crazy wizard, Dorothy is very grateful that she is back at home and welcomed with open arms.

Another great movie I love is “Star Wars.” We don’t have enough time for me to tell you about all the different stories within this movie. One would argue that this story is about good conquering evil. However, my favorite part of the story is when evil decides to do good and change for the best.

These stories have something in common with today’s gospel from Luke. It tells the story of a son that took his inheritance, ran away and spent ALL of the money his father had given him. After suffering for some time, he decided to go back home. His father welcomed him with open arms and had a party in his honor. Now, you may think that it sounds kind of crazy for the dad to not be upset with his son. Yet, the father was so happy that his son came back home and admitted his wrong doing.

The significance of this story is for us all to learn and understand that God loves us the same way. We may find it hard to follow the commandments, but God still loves us and we can change. We may not attend Mass for a long time, but God still loves us and we can always start going back to church. We may have done something horrible and feel that God will not accept our behavior, but God still loves us. We can always go back home to God. We can always start over and change for the better.

Imagine you have done a very bad thing at home. Isn’t it nice to know that your parents or guardians will love and accept you back home, no matter what? Wouldn’t it be horrible if you did something bad and your parent or guardian said, “GO AWAY! NEVER COME BACK!!!” That would be so sad. It is comforting to know that we can always apologize for our actions and be welcomed back into the arms of those that love us – no matter what! God wants us to understand that we are always safe with Him.

Let us pray: Heavenly Father, help me to truly try my best to honor you by following the commandments. Help me to know that I can always change for the best and God will always welcome me with open arms. Amen.

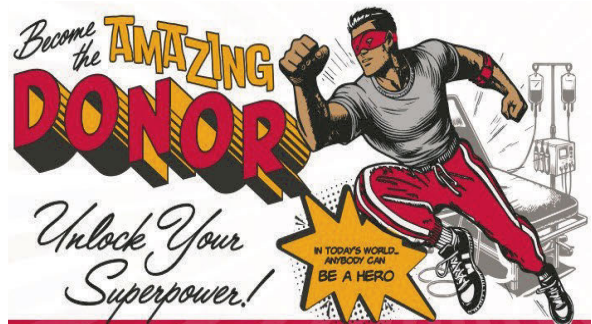

El Espíritu del Padre Frank

Hoy es el Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma. ¿Adónde se ha ido el tiempo? El Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma se conoce como *Domingo de Laetare*. *Laetare*, simplemente, significa regocijarse. Este domingo establece un tono de alegre anticipación del misterio pascual, al igual que las vestimentas de rosa que se usan este fin de semana.

Uno de mis evangelios favoritos es la historia del hijo pródigo. Cada vez que leo este pasaje, obtengo una nueva perspectiva. Esta lectura es muy interesante. Creo que nos gusta identificarnos con el hijo pródigo. A veces nos hemos extraviado y cometido errores, y luego recuperamos la cordura, nos arrepentimos y somos perdonados. Esto nos da una sensación de bienestar. ¿Te has preguntado alguna vez si te pareces más al otro hijo? La ira y los celos del otro hijo le impiden entrar en la fiesta, la celebración y el Reino. Está tan consumido por el celo y la rectitud que está ciego al perdón y la compasión. Probablemente no queramos admitirlo, pero creo que hay algo del "otro" hijo en cada uno de nosotros.

La verdadera historia trata sobre el padre, que vela y espera el regreso de su hijo. No le preocupan las disculpas ni las explicaciones, sino que está dispuesto a perdonar y celebrar. ¿Sabías que la palabra *pródigo* significa derrochador desmedido? Esto no solo describe el estilo de vida de un hijo, sino también el amor y el perdón del padre. Estamos llamados a ser más como el padre y a ser derrochadores con el perdón. ¿Te imaginas cómo sería nuestro mundo si todos estuviéramos dispuestos a perdonar? ¡Aprendamos una lección del evangelio de hoy y seamos *extravagantes* con nuestra fe!
