FR. FRANK'S FIRE

Happy Easter! Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter and we are still filled with Easter joy. Next weekend we will celebrate the Ascension and the following Sunday will be Pentecost. Pentecost marks the end of the Easter Season.

“I want to love God – but how do I?” This question is asked by many people. How do I show God that I truly love him? In the Gospel, Jesus gives us the perfect answer, “*Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me.*” A very simple answer and yet one that is extremely difficult to live out.

Again, we are reminded of the importance of the Ten Commandments. Jesus did not come to abolish the law – but instead, is the fulfillment of the law. In addition to the Ten Commandments, Jesus again reminds of the importance of loving one another. We are to be loving, forgiving and compassionate people. The challenge is that we are to love not only those who love us – but our enemies as well. This is only possible with God’s grace. Let our prayer this weekend be – Lord, give us the grace to love as you do.

Happy Mother’s Day! This is a great day when we have the opportunity to honor our mothers. Today we give thanks to God for the gift of our moms, whether living or deceased. It is a day to honor not only our biological moms, but also all those who have played a maternal role in our lives.

Today may be a difficult day for many. My mother died in 2001 after a battle with cancer. Mother’s Day has been difficult since then, but I am truly grateful to God for the gift of my mom – she was always there for me for both support and challenge. Over time, I have realized that I can be grateful and sad and the same time. Jesus reminds us that we can be joyful in the midst of sorrow – because God is with us. Yes, we can still honor our moms today, even if they have gone home to God. Offer a prayer for your mom and say thank you to God for the gift of your mother.



Today, let us honor all those who have cared for and nurtured us during our lives. Let us honor those who were there when we needed advice, or were willing to help mend our wounds or give us a shoulder to cry on. To all of these women let us say “thank you!” Let us be grateful to all those who show us how to love and care for each other.

I am mindful that this day may be painful for those who have had a difficult relationship with their mothers. Being a mom is not easy and sometimes mistakes are made, misunderstandings occur, and anger takes over. This is a time to look to Christ and ask for the grace to forgive, and allow God’s love to be your model and guide. This can also be a difficult day for those who want to have children, but have not been so blessed or perhaps have lost a child. Let us continue to pray for those families, and ask for the protection and care of the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph. May the suffering of Christ heal all of our wounds and may Christ’s resurrection bring us the gift of peace.

Hey, Kids!



"If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Jesus said this to his disciples before he left them. It was a very powerful statement and important for us all to know.

We know that there are 10 commandments. When you look at each commandment, you can conclude that each one will make us a better person as long as we follow them. The first 3 commandments are about our relationship with God. Think about it; 3 out of 10 of the commandments are about the relationship with God. Put God first; go to church; and use his name with respect. Those seem very easy to follow but how often do we hear people say, "Oh my God!" when they are angry? Or how many times do we justify not putting aside time for God on Sundays by not attending Mass and putting something else first? Can we say we put God first and honor Sunday as His day if we didn't attend mass? No, we must put God first and honor him each week.

The rest of the commandments can be summed up as: don't lie, don't cheat, don't be jealous, don't steal, don't kill, and respect your parents. Jesus was setting us up to be good people. He knew that anything that goes against the commandments would make people angry or hurt humanity. When someone lies to you, how do you feel? It feels bad. Jesus wanted our words and actions to give joy to everyone around us. He knew when people did not follow the commandments, people ended up hurt and joyless. If we love God, we must follow the commandments. In turn, people will get along.

I believe that when we follow commandments, we feel good. We feel at peace with God. Think about the times that you have chosen to do the right thing vs the wrong thing. How do you feel? That good feeling means that the Holy Spirit is within you. You must try to listen to God speak to you through the Holy Spirit. The Spirit will guide you in following the commandments.

Let's pray: Holy Spirit, please guide me in all that I say and do. Help me to choose the right words when I speak. Help me to act in a way in which Jesus would be proud of me. Allow me to look at myself and see the Light that lives within me and spread it to all those I encounter. Amen.

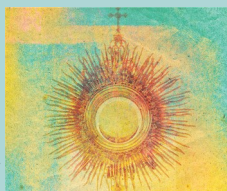

What is Holy Hour and what are the Benefits? Part II



HOLY HOUR

Holy Hour is devotional tradition of spending one continuous hour in prayer in the presence of Jesus Christ, typically exposed in the Blessed Sacrament. Its purpose is to foster a deeper personal relationship with God through adoration, meditation, and reparation.

More benefits of the Holy Hour

It allows for Universal and Intercessory Graces that has Global Impact: According to many saints, every Holy Hour affects the entire world, bringing others closer to Christ and opening the "floodgates of God's mercy." **"Reparation:** The hour serves as reparation for the sins, indifference, and "great faults and crimes" of the world.

Vocations and Families: Regular adoration is linked to an increase in priestly vocations and the strengthening of marriages and family lives.

Salvation of Souls: It is believed that through intercession during a Holy Hour, souls on the "precipice of hell" may receive the grace of conversion.

Jesus, we trust in You. Come, Holy Spirit, Come.

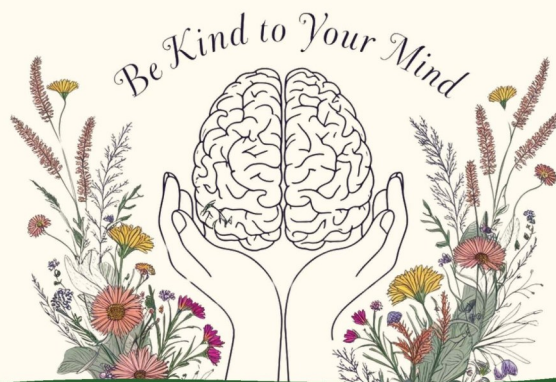
