

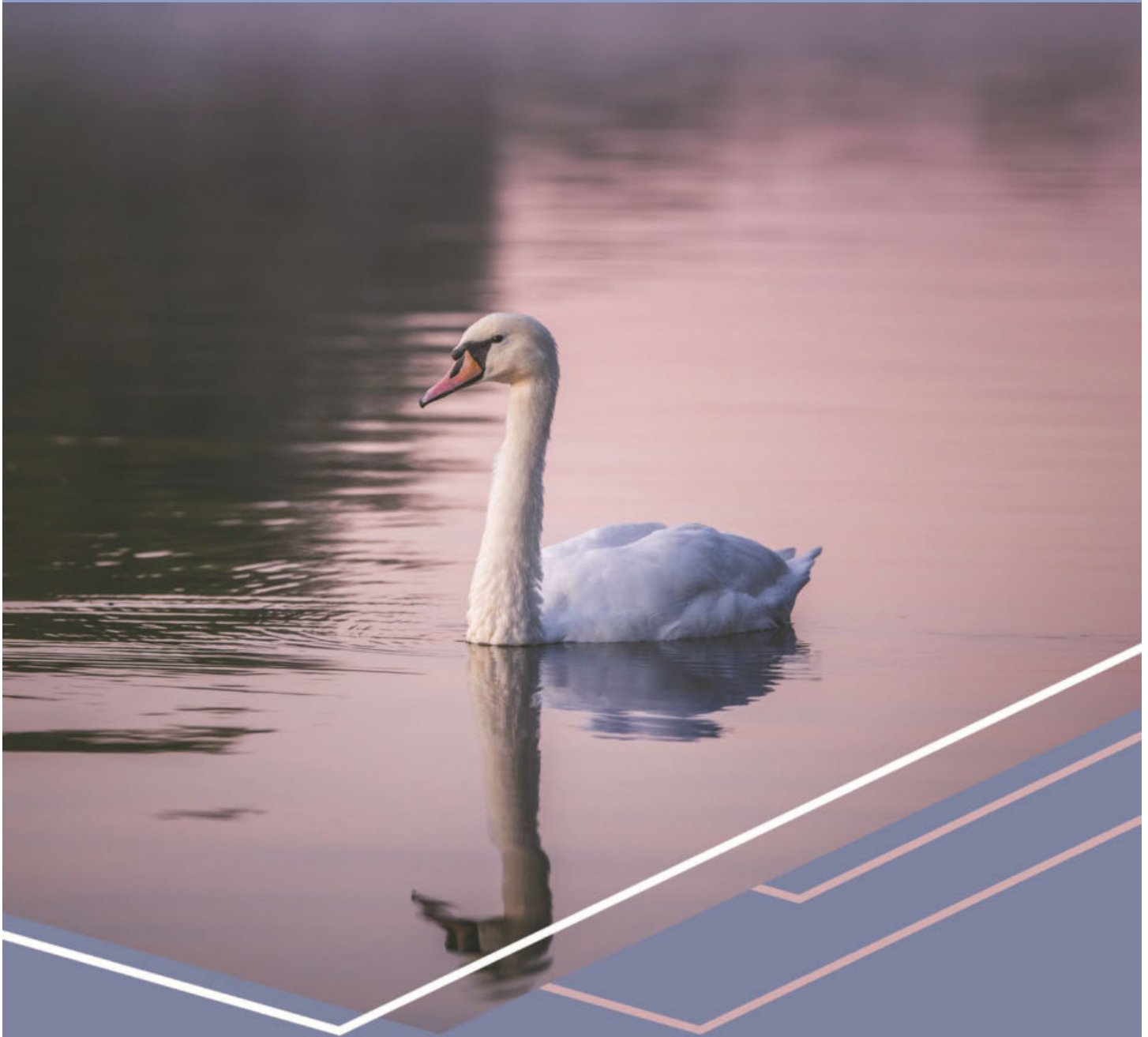

Father Frank's Fire

Happy Easter! We still have two weeks until Pentecost Sunday. I trust that you are still filled with Easter joy, for our Savior Jesus Christ is truly Risen.

In today's gospel, Jesus is trying to prepare his disciples for his leaving. Jesus is aware of the confusion and fear that his death will have on his closest followers. He tells them, as he tells us today, *"Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid."* To be honest this is exactly how they felt as they witnessed Jesus' death. The big question I am sure was, "Now what?" The disciples did not understand that Jesus had a plan and that he would not leave them alone. *"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you."* The disciples were in good hands because on Pentecost they were filled with the Holy Spirit (that is why we celebrate Easter until then) and with the wisdom, strength, knowledge and courage to bring the Good News of salvation to the ends of the earth.

Pentecost is the birthday of the Church. On that day the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and the Church – the Holy Spirit has never left us. Let us rejoice that we have been placed in the love and power of the Holy Spirit who will teach us everything and remind us of what Jesus said. Do not be afraid or troubled, for the power of God working through the Holy Spirit is with us!

I have a picture of my mom on my nightstand so I can see her every morning when I wake up. My mother is not in heaven; she is still with me on this Earth, but I enjoy looking at her picture every day. I love my mother very much and I know she likes to hear me say, "Mom, I love you!"

Do you think your mother likes to hear you tell her that you love her? Of course she does! But do you know what your mother likes even more? She likes for you to show her that you love her. How are some ways you can **show** your mother that you love her? You can make your bed every morning, pick up your clothes, take out the trash, maybe not fight with your brothers and/or sisters. Another important thing is to obey her when she tells you to do something. Remember, your mom likes to hear you say, "I love you," but she likes it even more when you show her that you love her with your actions.

Do you love Jesus? I'm sure you do! Do you think Jesus likes to hear you say, "I love you?" I know he does, but he likes it even better when you **show** Him that you love Him. What ways can we show Jesus we love him? Jesus told us how to love him. Remember Jesus said, "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teachings."

The Gospels are full of things that Jesus taught us. You show him that you love him by obeying his teachings. When we are kind to everyone and show others that we care for our friends and family, that is a great way to show our love to Jesus. It is the small things that really count and show this world that Jesus is and always will be in our hearts. You can show your love for Jesus by bringing a flower to someone you know that is having a bad day, helping your siblings with homework or chores, or you can be extra kind to a fellow student you know is having a difficult time in school. You also can hug your parents and tell them you love them. Go to church on Sunday and tell Jesus you love him. When you leave here today, don't forget to tell everyone you love them, but more importantly, **show** them that you love them by doing the things that Jesus taught us.

Let's pray: Dear Lord, we have come to your house today to say, "I love you." Help us to go out into the world today and show you that we love you by obeying your teachings. Amen.

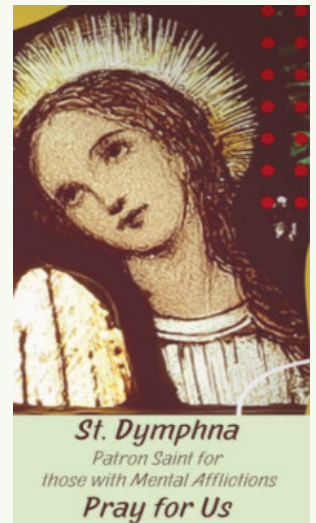

In the past we have asked for gift cards, gas cards, canned goods and assorted food pantry items, and you have overwhelmed us with your generosity. At this time, we find the greatest need of the people we serve to be financial assistance for rent, mortgages and utilities, and so we are asking for money. We currently have 35 families on our rolls. Their needs vary and include past due rent ranging from \$1,000 - \$1,600, which we can provide one time in a year, as well as past due utilities, and sometimes a unique situation involving car repairs or other expenses.

In addition to providing financial support and food from the pantry, we also spend time with our families, directing them to other possible sources of help. The needs right now are growing and it's obviously very hard for us to tell people "No, we can't help."

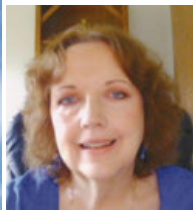

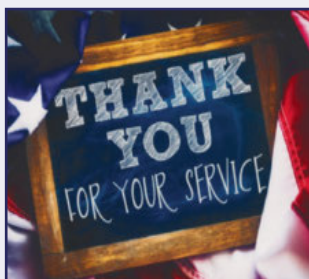

1. Naturaleza de los ángeles

Dotados de inteligencia y voluntad libre, superiores a los seres humanos en naturaleza, pero no divinos.

2. Jerarquía angélica

La Iglesia, siguiendo a autores como Pseudo-Dionisio Areopagita y Santo Tomás de Aquino, acepta una jerarquía de nueve coros angélicos organizados en tres tríadas:

Primer Trío (adoran directamente a Dios):

Serafines, Querubines y Tronos

Segundo Trío (administran el universo):

Dominaciones, Virtudes y Potestades

Tercer Trío (se relacionan más directamente con la humanidad): Principados, Arcángeles y Ángeles.

3. Función de los ángeles

Alaban a Dios sin cesar (Apocalipsis 4).

Mensajeros de Dios (por eso "ángel" significa "mensajero").

Protegen a los seres humanos, como los ángeles custodios o guardianes (Mateo 18:10). Asisten en la lucha espiritual (por ejemplo, San Miguel Arcángel contra Satanás). Acompañan a los fieles al cielo después de la muerte.

5. Culto y devoción

La Iglesia enseña que no se debe adorar a los ángeles, ya que solo Dios merece adoración (latría). Se permite y recomienda venerar (dulia) a los ángeles, especialmente a: San Miguel Arcángel (defensor contra el mal) San Gabriel Arcángel (mensajero de la Encarnación), San Rafael Arcángel (guía y sanador)

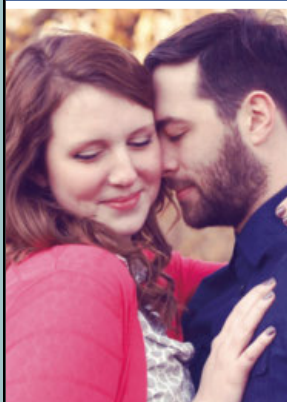
