FR. FRANK'S FIRE

Happy Easter! Keeping celebrating the day of Christ's Resurrection until the birthday of the Church on Pentecost!

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus tells us, "Do not let your hearts be troubled." I find this ironic because if we are willing to take a good and honest look at ourselves we find that our hearts are very troubled. We are troubled about the economy and personal finances and we worry if we are going to be able to pay our bills and provide for our families. Our world and neighborhoods are filled with violence and hatred. We do not know if we can keep our children safe. Families are torn and broken because of mistrust, unwillingness to compromise, and by infidelity. Our teens and young adults seek to escape their problems and responsibilities through alcohol, drugs, and inappropriate relationships. Seniors are anxious not knowing if they have the means to afford their medications and long-term care. There is war and the threat of war around the globe. There are scandals in politics, corporations and in the church. Our hearts are very troubled.

In the midst of chaos and confusion Jesus says it will be okay. Jesus tells us that he is "the way, the truth and the life." Jesus does not tell us that he brings the way, the truth and the life but rather that he IS our life and salvation. Jesus tells us that if we follow him we can have access to the way, the truth, and the life. In simpler terms, there is hope for us if we are willing to believe.

Jesus gives us more than hope because he promises us that we can share in his power and even do far greater works than he did. "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these." I love telling our children that if you think what Jesus did was something, think of what we can do – if only we are open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. We can do far greater things than what Jesus did. Why are we so stubborn and slow to believe? Jesus invites us to share the way, the truth and the life. If we are willing to work together, we can make a difference in our world. If we listen to Christ, our hearts would not be troubled, but rather our hearts would be at peace knowing that our God is with us. Do you want to live with a troubled or anxious heart? Turn to Christ who is the only way to find peace not only in our hearts but also in our families, neighborhoods, parishes and world. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. Let us have the courage and determination to follow.

You can return your pledge to the parish office or simply drop it in the regular Sunday collection. I thank you in advance for your generosity.

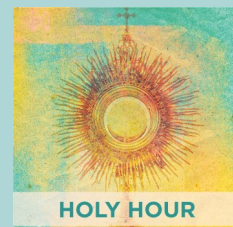

GENERATION TO GENERATION: ANSWER THE CALL

What is Holy Hour and what are the Benefits? Part I



Holy Hour is devotional tradition of spending one continuous hour in prayer in the presence of Jesus Christ, typically exposed in the Blessed Sacrament. Its purpose is to foster a deeper personal relationship with God through adoration, meditation, and reparation.

Holy Hour helps one develop Personal Spiritual Fruits

Divine Intimacy: It fosters a deeper union with Christ, often described as a "one-on-one" friendship that transforms the soul into his likeness.

Inner Peace: Adoration provides a "peace that surpasses all understanding," helping to calm the heart amidst life's challenges.

Spiritual Healing: It acts as "spiritual therapy," offering relief from bad habits, mediocrity, and the "rays of Jesus" that can lead to both spiritual and physical healing.

Wisdom and Strength: Spending time in the Real Presence provides the "light of faith" for the mind and the "fire of love" (strength) for the will to fulfill one's daily duties.

Blessings and Protection: The final blessing with the monstrance signifies divine protection and grace poured out upon the faithful.

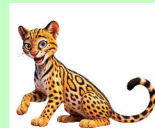

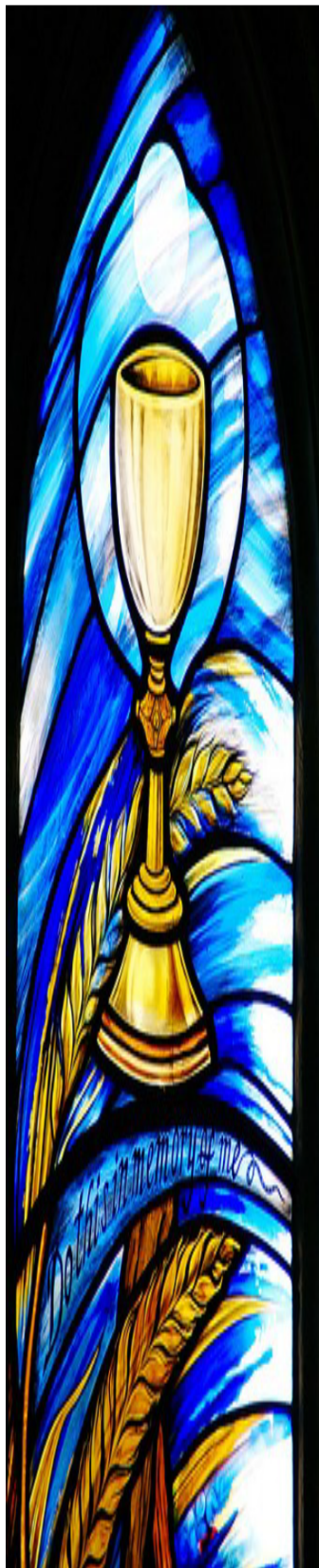

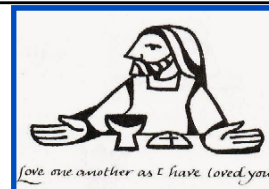

En el evangelio de este fin de semana, Jesús nos dice: “No se turbe su corazón”. Me parece irónico, porque si estamos dispuestos a mirarnos a nosotros mismos con honestidad y detenimiento, descubriremos que nuestros corazones están muy turbados. Nos preocupa la economía y nuestras finanzas personales; nos preocupa no saber si podremos pagar nuestras facturas y proveer para nuestras familias. Nuestro mundo y nuestros vecindarios están plagados de violencia y odio. No sabemos si lograremos mantener a nuestros hijos a salvo. Las familias se encuentran desgarradas y rotas a causa de la desconfianza, la falta de disposición para ceder y la infidelidad. Nuestros adolescentes y jóvenes adultos buscan escapar de sus problemas y responsabilidades a través del alcohol, las drogas y las relaciones inapropiadas. 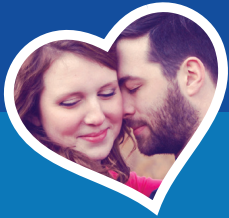
