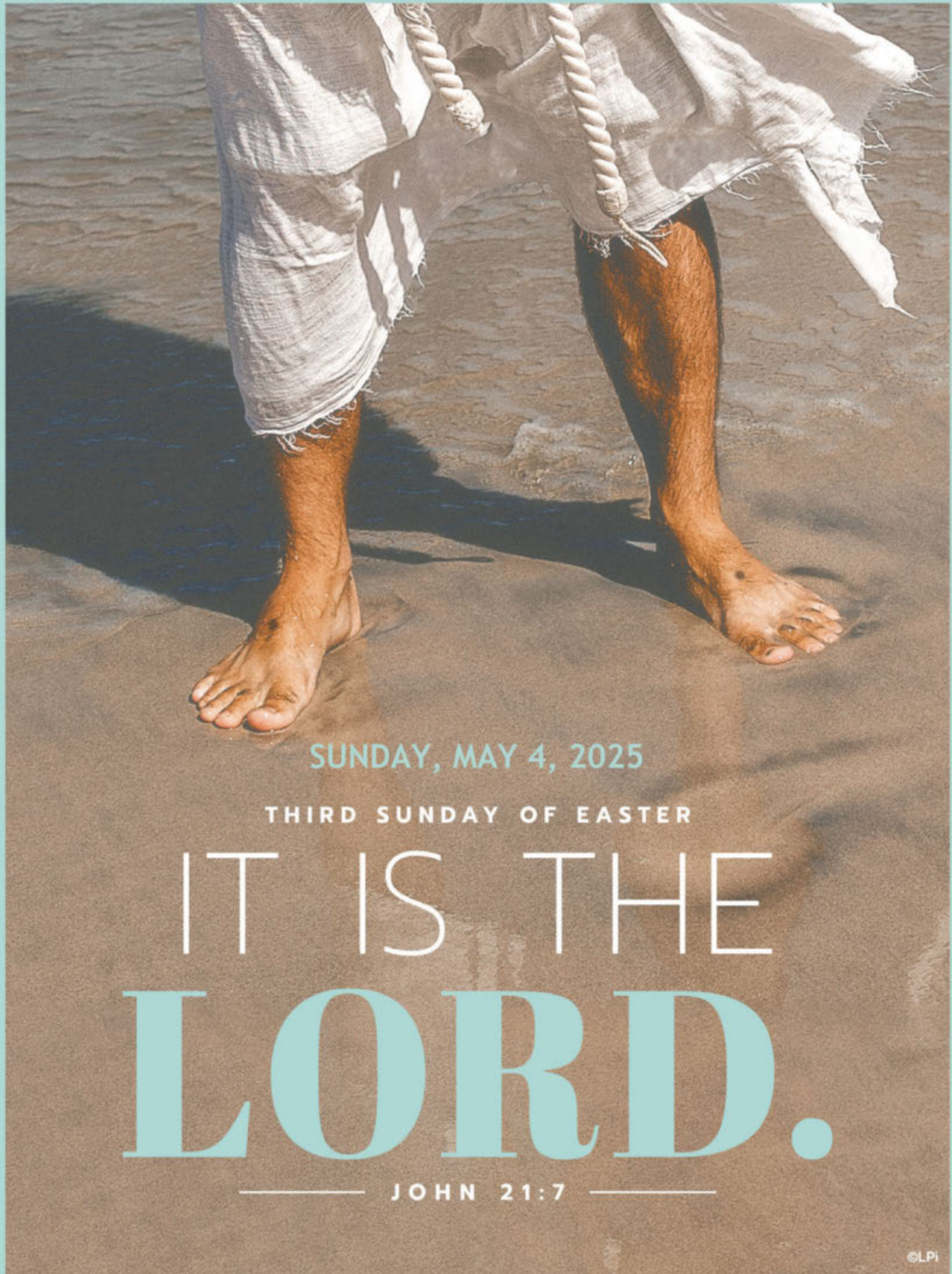

Father Frank's Fire

Happy Easter! Yes, we continue to celebrate Easter for 50 days and this will lead us to Pentecost Sunday in early June. In our gospel today, the disciples once again encounter the Risen Christ. The encounter between Peter and Jesus is both heartbreaking, and at the same time, heartwarming.

Jesus asks Peter three times, “do you love me?” This is heartbreaking because Peter was distressed because he realized that he had denied Jesus three times. It’s a vivid reminder of the lack of courage that Peter had. This is heartwarming because Jesus does not seem to scold, reprimand or dismiss him. Jesus simply replies, “Feed my lambs,” “Tend my sheep” and “Feed my sheep.” Jesus sees something in Peter that perhaps Peter did not see. Jesus sees that his relationship with Peter can be restored. Although Peter abandoned Jesus, Jesus offers him a way forward. Just as with Peter’s original call, Jesus again says, “Follow me.”

How many times do we abandon the Lord when things get difficult? How many times do we think that we know better than God? Jesus always gives us a way forward to leave our past behind. In order to follow Jesus, we are called to feed and tend to Jesus’ sheep. Simply put, we must love and care for one another. Jesus always offers us ways to restore our friendship with him.

Papal Conclave

The past week has truly been historic for our Church. We watched the very simplified funeral of Pope Francis. Even in his death, he continued to teach us about humility. While a Pope, he was also a man that would have to stand before the judgement throne of God. Let us continue to pray for the repose of his soul. Eternal Rest Grant unto him, O Lord, and let the Perpetual Light Shine upon him.

The eyes of the world now focus on the College of Cardinals. After a period of mourning, the College of Cardinals will meet in a Papal Conclave. The conclave generally begins 15 to 20 days after the death of a Pope. The Conclave will begin May 7. Cardinals under the age of 80 are eligible to vote and will gather in isolation.

There are currently 135 Cardinals under the age of 80. They will vote several times a day. A candidate requires 2/3 majority of the votes to be elected the next Pope.

I ask you to pray that the Cardinal electors will listen to the Holy Spirit during their discussions as well as their voting. There is always speculation about who the next Pope will be. While I can only remember the election of Popes John Paul I, John Paul II, Benedict XVI and Francis – each time I was surprised at the election, and the front runner usually was not elected. There is an Old Italian saying that says, the one who walks into a conclave as Pope (the front-runner) walks out as a Cardinal. Instead of speculating, let us continue to pray for the election of the successor of St. Peter. Pray until the white smoke emerges from the Sistine Chapel and we hear the words, “*Habemus Papam*,” we have a Pope.

His love for God and the Blessed Virgin Mary is contagious. We laughed and cried all within the same hour. 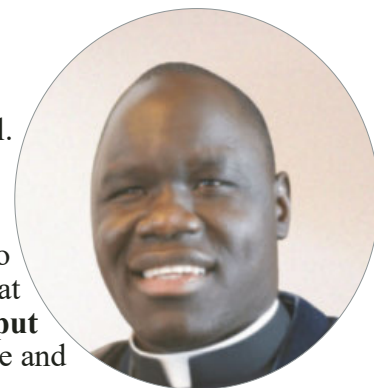

Have you ever done something you have regretted and didn't have an opportunity to apologize for what you had done? It can be a hard thing to overcome — to hurt someone and then not be able to apologize for or hear that you are forgiven for something you feel bad about. We remember the story of the Passion of Christ; Jesus suffered a great deal during this time. Peter told Jesus before he died that he would never disown him. Jesus told him, "This very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." Peter did not want to believe this was true, but sure enough, what Jesus said became true. When Peter heard the rooster crow, he wept and became very sad. Unfortunately, Jesus died before Peter had a chance to ask Jesus in person for forgiveness, but the story does not end there.

Shortly after Jesus rose from the dead, he appeared to his disciples while they were out fishing. He asked Peter, "Do you love me?" Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved him and each time Peter replied, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus instructed Peter to tend and feed his sheep. The sheep Jesus is talking about is us — the people. Jesus was telling Peter that he wanted him to share God's Word with all of us. Something they don't really mention in this gospel is how even though Jesus was correct about Peter disowning him, he still forgave Peter.

Jesus understood that Peter was very scared. After all, it was a scary thing to see Jesus suffer so greatly. After Jesus' death, Peter stayed committed to his love for Jesus. We know he felt horrible for what he did. However Peter still loved Jesus very much and continued to follow him. Jesus forgave Peter. We know this because Jesus still wanted Peter to spread the Word of God to everyone.

It is important for us to know that God never stops loving us — even when we may question Him. I think the important message here is that it can be hard to follow Jesus. We may not do it well 100% of the time. We may question how things unfold in our lives and wonder where God's hand is in all the tragedy we see. However, if we continue to focus on Him and we continue to spread the Word of God to others, we will make this world a better place by simply acting like Jesus. Nothing can erase God's love for us.

Let us pray: Dear God, thank you for loving me no matter what. Help me to care for people by sharing your Word. Help me lead people to you with my words and actions. Amen.

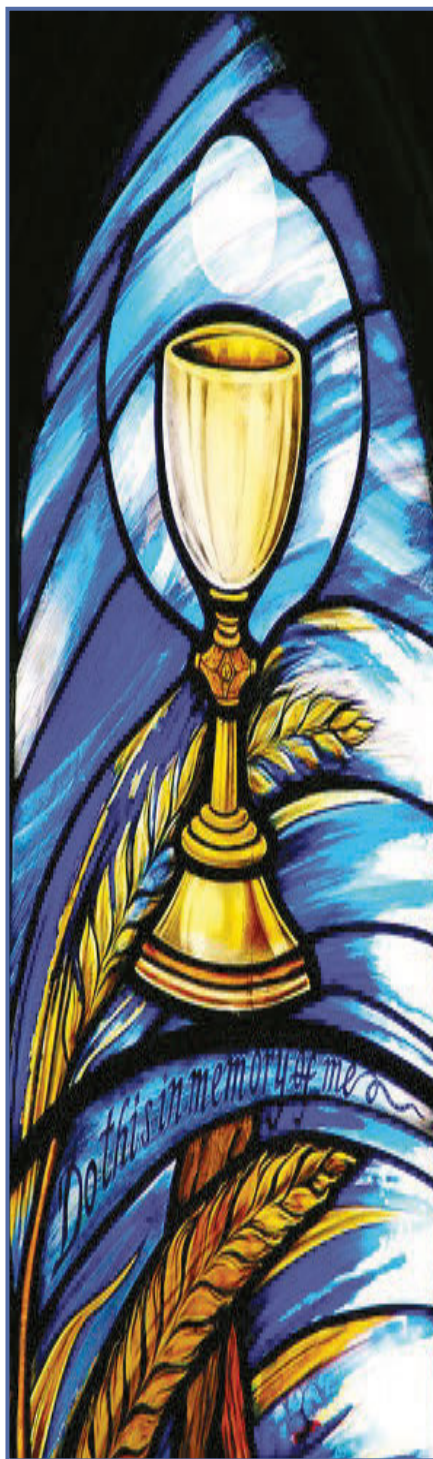

El Espíritu del Padre Frank

¡Felices Pascuas! Sí, continuamos celebrando la Pascua durante cincuenta días, lo que nos llevará al Domingo de Pentecostés a principios de junio. En nuestro evangelio de hoy, los discípulos se encuentran una vez más con Cristo Resucitado. El encuentro entre Pedro y Jesús es desgarrador y, a la vez, conmovedor.

Jesús le pregunta a Pedro tres veces: "¿Me amas?". Esto es desgarrador porque Pedro estaba angustiado al darse cuenta de que había negado a Jesús tres veces. Un vívido recordatorio de su falta de valentía. Esto es conmovedor porque Jesús no parece regañarlo, reprenderlo o despedirlo. Jesús simplemente responde: "Apacienta mis corderos", "Pastorea mis ovejas" y "Apacienta mis ovejas". Jesús ve algo en Pedro que quizás él no vio. Jesús ve que su relación con Pedro puede restablecerse. Aunque Pedro abandonó a Jesús, Jesús le ofrece un camino a seguir. Al igual que con el llamado original de Pedro, Jesús vuelve a decir: "Sígueme."

¿Cuántas veces abandonamos al Señor cuando las cosas se ponen difíciles? ¿Cuántas veces creemos saber más que Dios? Jesús siempre nos da una salida para dejar atrás nuestro pasado. Para seguir a Jesús, estamos llamados a alimentar y cuidar a sus ovejas. En pocas palabras, debemos amarnos y cuidarnos unos a otros. Jesús siempre nos ofrece maneras de restaurar nuestra amistad con él.

Cónclave Papal

La semana pasada fue verdaderamente histórica para nuestra Iglesia. Asistimos al funeral, muy sencillo, del Papa Francisco. Incluso en su muerte, continuó enseñándonos humildad. Siendo Papa, también fue un hombre que tendría que comparecer ante el trono del juicio de Dios. Sigamos orando por el descanso eterno de su alma. Concédale, oh Señor, el descanso eterno y que la Luz Perpetua brille para él.

La atención del mundo se centra ahora en el Colegio de Cardenales. Tras un período de luto, el Colegio de Cardenales se reunirá en un Cónclave Papal. El cónclave suele comenzar entre quince y veinte días después del fallecimiento de un Papa, es decir, entre el 6 y el 11 de mayo. Los cardenales menores de 80 años pueden votar y se reunirán en aislamiento.

Actualmente hay 135 cardenales menores de 80 años. Votarán varias veces al día. Un candidato necesita una mayoría de dos tercios de los votos para ser elegido próximo Papa.

Les pido que oren para que los cardenales electores escuchen al Espíritu Santo tanto durante sus debates como en sus votaciones. Siempre se especula sobre quién será el próximo Papa. Aunque solo recuerdo la elección de los papas Juan Pablo I, Juan Pablo II, Benedicto XVI y Francisco, cada vez me sorprendía más la elección, y el favorito generalmente no era elegido. Un antiguo proverbio italiano dice: "Quien entra en un cónclave como Papa (el favorito) sale como Cardenal". En lugar de especular, sigamos orando por la elección del sucesor de San Pedro. Oremos hasta que salga el humo blanco de la Capilla Sixtina y oigamos las palabras "*Habemus Papam*", que tenemos un Papa.

Por qué la Pascua dura 50 días?

La Pascua dura 50 días porque este período, llamado Tiempo Pascual, representa el tiempo que pasó desde la Resurrección de Jesús hasta la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Según la tradición cristiana, Jesús resucitó y permaneció con sus discípulos durante 40 días antes de ascender al cielo; luego, los apóstoles esperaron 10 días más hasta Pentecostés, cuando recibieron el Espíritu Santo. Así, la Pascua comienza el Domingo de Resurrección y termina 50 días después, en Pentecostés, celebrando la victoria de Cristo sobre la muerte y el nacimiento de la Iglesia.
