Father Frank's Fire

Today's readings speak to us about love. Jesus tells us what true Christian love is and not only does Jesus tell us what authentic love is, he showed us with his very life. Jesus tells us, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." Is this not what Jesus did when he opened his arms on the cross? Did he not give us an example to follow – laying down our lives for another?

Every time I hear this gospel, I think of my parents. I feel that my parents both laid down their lives for their children. My dad worked in a factory and my mom was a homemaker. In particular, my mom's entire life was her family. She did not have a career and we lived on my dad's salary. Very seldom did we go on vacation, except once a year we went fishing in Michigan. We did not go out to dinner and we survived with one car. We had one bathroom for a family of five.

My parents sacrificed so that their children could have a better life. I think this is an example of the true meaning of Jesus' words today, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." I think today we should be mindful of all the people that have sacrificed for us, to make our lives better.

Prayer Teams

Just a reminder that I would like to form prayer teams that would be available after Mass to pray for others. Instead of coming to the priest and asking for a prayer sometime in the future – the prayer teams will be available and offer the prayer with the asker. I know some may feel reluctant to pray for others because they may not have the words. But there is nothing to fear, as there is no wrong-way to pray.

In order to form this ministry, I will need volunteers to form prayer teams. No experience is necessary. Formation will be offered so that the prayer intercessors become comfortable praying with others. Remember Jesus says that where two or three gather in his name – he will take his place among them.

I ask that you think about if God is calling you to be part of a prayer team. I would like to invite you to an **initial meeting on Tuesday, May 28 at 6:30PM**. Excerpts from the Lectionary for

6th Sunday of Easter May 5, 2024

"God sent his only Son into the world so that we might have life through Him." But how do we know that the Risen Christ—God in our midst—still lives with us in this day and age? It's simple! Through the love that we show for one another. If we truly love each other, our love will bring

forth new life! All the world will know! But does that even seem possible in today's world where selfishness and meanness abound? Do we truly know God's love? Do we feel God's Holy Spirit working in our lives each day? This idea was an earth-shaking development in the Church's idea of those who were invited to participate in the life of Christ and in the community of His believers.

In today's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the Holy Spirit fell upon ALL who were listening to the Word — Jews and Gentiles alike! This mission of our church today still calls us to share in the life, love and mission of Jesus. And as the gospel tells us, if we keep Jesus' commandments, we will surely bear fruit that will remain for others to taste and see.

This mission of the Church began in the household of Cornelius and continues today, as each person chooses to be an active part of the life and work of Jesus. Christian love demands sacrifice and is costly in terms of personal commitment. Loving like Christ means giving our lives for others, just as Jesus gave His life for us. Even children know that self-sacrificing love is something very special indeed!

I remember when I was young, my friends and I enjoyed making friendship bracelets. They were a little difficult to make, at first, but I

remember my friend taking the time to show me how to do it. She enjoyed showing me how to make them because she also enjoyed her hobby. She showed me how to make different patterns in the braid. Then, when I was done with my masterpieces, she would praise me for my work. It was a really nice gesture on her part to teach me how to make them. Then we would give them away to other friends, and they would smile and be grateful for the gift. Our joy came in seeing them wearing the bracelets and wanting more of them to share with their friends. Wouldn't you say that it feels good to show someone how to do something that you enjoy doing yourself?

When Jesus taught us about love, I believe he felt the same way as my friend did. He knew that his purpose on earth was to teach us how to love one another. He told many different stories (or parables) so that people would understand why it was so important to love one another. He spent so much time preaching to people about the importance of love. He wanted us to know that God loved us all the same. Let's think about that for a second. God loves US so much that He sent us Jesus to teach US how to love. It seems like such an easy thing to do; love one another.

However, when you turn on the news, it can be a bit sad to see how many people simply don't know how to follow the commandments or try to love one another. It can be hard to love someone who is cruel, mean or who doesn't look like us. We can easily break a commandment if we take our sights off of Jesus. So, in those moments where you find it hard to love, close your eyes and ask God to help you. Ask Him what would Jesus do right now? How would he react if someone did this to him? It is important to do this because Jesus was perfection, and he never did anything wrong. So, if we use Jesus as our guide, we will stay loyal to the commandments. God will always lead us to love, but we have to focus on Him so that we act with love.

Let's pray: God, thank you for sending me Jesus to show me how to love ALL of the people I encounter. Amen.

Cada vez que escucho este evangelio, pienso en mis padres. Siento que mis padres dieron sus vidas por sus hijos. Mi papá trabajaba en una fábrica y mi mamá era ama de casa. En particular, toda la vida de mi mamá fue su familia. Ella no tenía carrera y vivíamos del salario de mi papá. Muy rara vez íbamos de vacaciones, excepto una vez al año que íbamos a pescar a Michigan. No salimos a cenar y sobrevivimos con un coche. Teníamos un baño para una familia de cinco.

Mis padres se sacrificaron para que sus hijos pudieran tener una vida mejor. Creo que este es un ejemplo del verdadero significado de las palabras de Jesús hoy: "Nadie tiene mayor amor que este: dar la vida por los amigos". Creo que hoy deberíamos ser conscientes de todas las personas que se han sacrificado por nosotros para mejorar nuestras vidas

Grupos de Oración


