Presider: O, God, + come to our assistance


Assembly: Lord, make haste to help us.

Presider: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit Assembly: As it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.


Musician begins Hymn immediately.

Presider: Let us pray...


Almighty God, our source of unfailing light, from early morning we seek you in the sanctuary, for your love is better than life itself.

SCRIPTURE: Hebrews 2:9b-10

A reading from the letter to the Hebrews:

We see Jesus, who for a little while was made lower than the angels. Because of God's wonderful kindness, Jesus became human and died for everyone. And now that Jesus has suffered and died, he is crowned with glory and honor!

Everything belongs to God and all things were created by his power. So God did the right thing when he made Jesus perfect by suffering, because through his suffering and death, Jesus led many of God's children to be saved and to share in his glory.

Jesus, and the people he makes holy, all belong to the same family.

Presider allows 30 seconds of silence. Lector remains seated. Presider stands and begins responsory:

Holding the book at the chair the presider introduces the Lords' Prayer with the following words, then places the book on the chair, and with hands raised in the orans position, and sings the Lord's Prayer with the cantor.

Presider: Gathering our prayers and praise into one, let us sing the words our Savior gave us: Our Father....

Remain standing.

CLOSING PRAYER:

Presider: Let us pray...

God of infinite compassion, to love you is to be made holy. Ground our hearts and our lives in your love.

By the death of your son, you give us hope for eternal life. By Christ's rising again, we will someday realize this hope in heaven, with Jesus, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

R: Amen.


BLESSING:
